



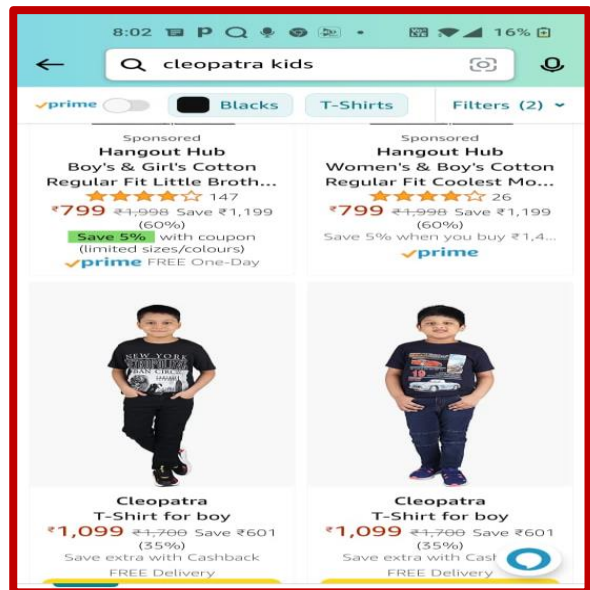

✚ **Class IV – Science – Air, Water & Weather :-**

The students performed a simple experiment using two containers, one each with hot water and cold water and a bottle with a balloon fixed on its mouth. They recorded their observations, the logical analysis of which led to their conclusion that Hot air rises and cold air settles down, this concept helped them gain insight into understanding of convection currents causing winds and thereby the occurrence of land breeze and sea breeze in coastal areas. The activity was an instant favourite with the kids!!



Hot & Cool Air Experiment

Observation: When a bottle with a balloon fixed on its mouth is kept in hot water, the balloon gets inflated. When the bottle is kept in cold water, the balloon gets deflated.

Conclusion: It is based on the scientific principle of expansion & contraction i.e. the matter expands when heated and contracts when cooled.



SCIENCE ACTIVITY

OBSERVATION In this activity I observed that air got filled in the balloon when the bottle was kept in the hot water and it got deflated when kept in the cold water.

CONCLUSION This activity concludes that hot air rises up.

- The topics for the upcoming week are as follows:

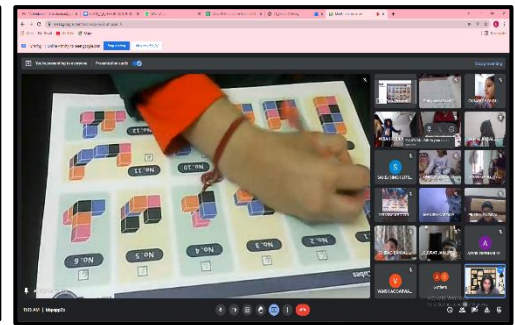
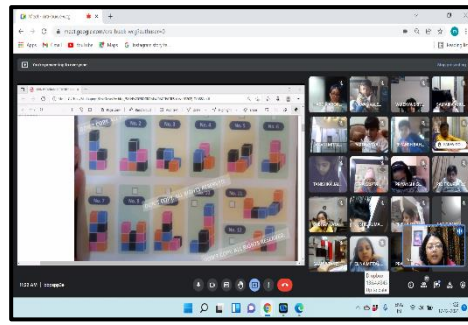
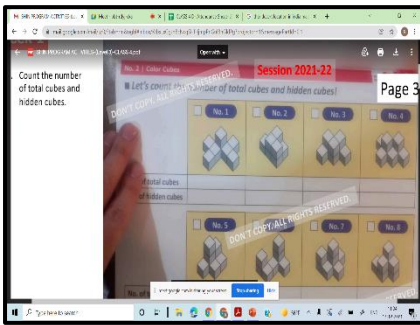

❖ SHIN Programme:-

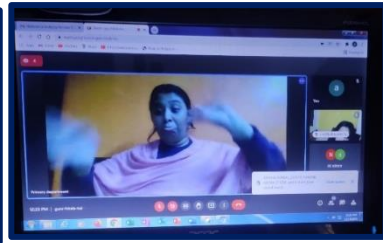
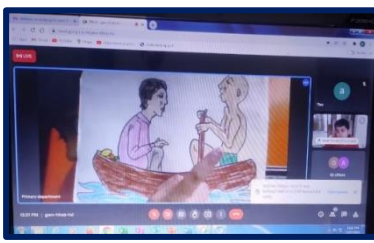

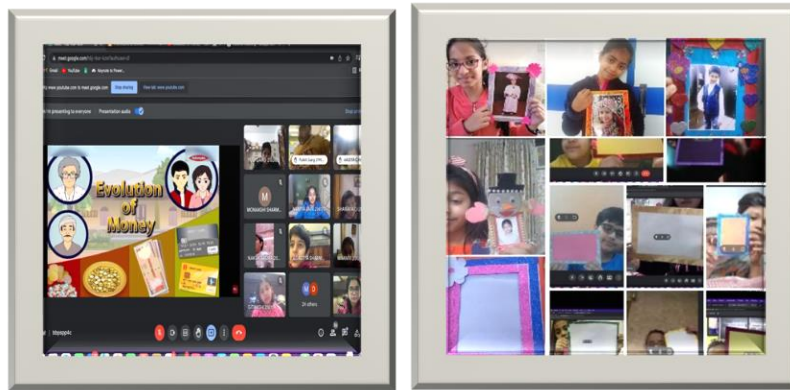
❖ **TED Club - Happy Morning Mantra:-**

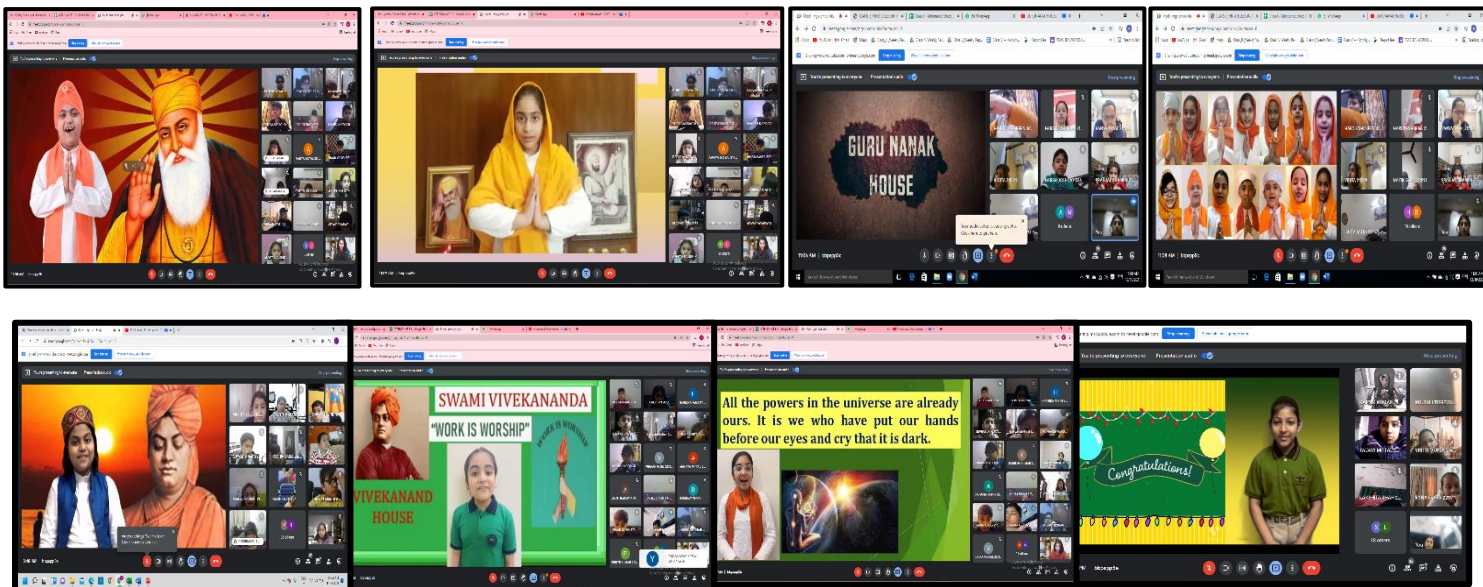
❖ **Financial Literacy:-**

❖ **Vivekanand and Gurunanak House Functions:-**

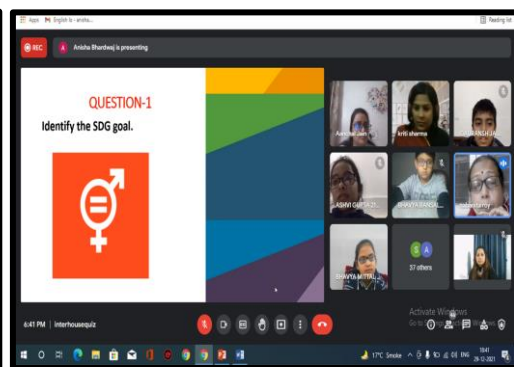

❖ Interhouse Quiz:-

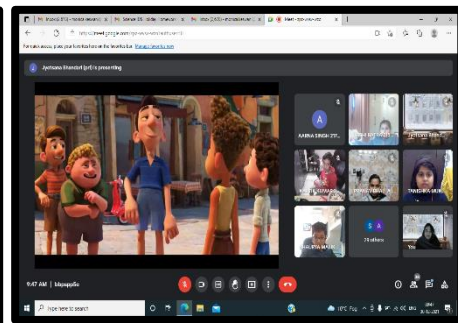
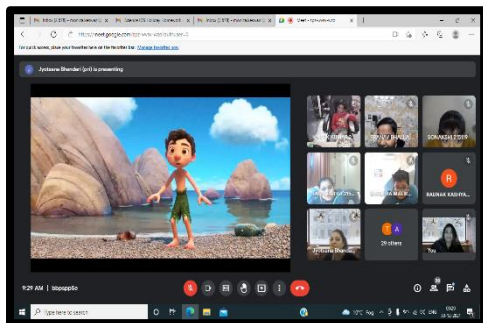

❖ **Road Safety Club:-**

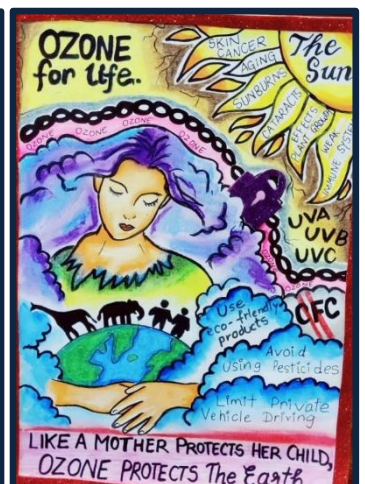
'Making roads safe starts with YOU. So, let's be a ROAD HERO!'
