

#### Class III - Mathematics - Building the Multiplication Tables:-






### Class III - Mathematics - Multiplication Flowers:-

### **SPECIAL INITIATIVES:-**

### ❖ <u>Elocution</u>:-

'Communication is a skill that can be learnt and all it needs is the willingness to do it'. Keeping this ideology in mind, the Elocution Period has been introduced in the Primary classes. The same is held once in every fortnight and aims at helping our young learners become confident orators, enabling them to express their thoughts effectively in all scenarios.







### ❖ SHIN Programme:-


Shin Activity Number 3 was conducted in classes III – V on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022. The activities were graded according to the three class levels. The activities were engrossing and helped in developing the analytical and logical reasoning skills among the students. The session was lively and interactive. The teachers as well as the students look forward to these interesting activities which help in the holistic development of the students.





#### **CACA - Anti-Bullying:-**

With an aim to create awareness about different kinds of bullying a webinar was conducted for the students of Classes IV and V on the topic – 'All About Bullying' on Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> January 2022. The same was organized on Google Meet along with live streaming so as to enable the maximum number of students to be part of it. More than 550 participants attended the session. The webinar aimed at apprising the young learners of different forms of bullying. The students were guided to 'KEEP TELLING' their near and dear ones until they 'LISTEN' and 'HELP'. The need to 'STOP & HELP' people who are affected by 'BULLYING' was stressed upon along with the need to LISTEN amongst ourselves, so that those who need us can reach out to us. At the end, there was an interactive session, followed by sharing of a worksheet on the topic with the students.





#### Concept Building Sessions:-

'A building is only as strong as its foundation.' To ensure a better understanding of the concepts and give our students an insight into the vital aspects of the subjects, Concept Building Sessions are being organized in Mathematics and English for the students of Classes III to VIII after the regular school hours. Two classess per week are held for each subject.

#### Newspaper in Education:-

A newspaper is a window to the world. To bring the world to the classroom, the discussion of the newspaper has become a regular activity during Class Teacher's period (CTP) in classes III to V. The practice keeps the students updated about the various social, political, and environmental issues in the world and also helps them enrich their vocabulary.

### ❖ Financial Literacy:-

To sensitise the students about the value of money and make them aware of its journey and evolution through trade, the Primary Department has initiated the Financial Literacy Project in Classes IV and V. Interesting worksheets have been designed by the teachers which are shared and discussed with students.

#### **E-Newsletter:**

To enable our students of Classes III-V, to explore and know more about the globe, they created and designed an E-Newsletter as part of their winter vacation holiday homework. They researched on the major environmental challenges faced by our partner countries-Australia, Oman and USA and elucidated simple ways to combat them thus contributing towards building up a responsible global community.

#### ❖ Green Warriors and Gardening Clubs - Street Play:-

With an aim to keep moving ahead towards sensitising the students, parents and community at large, the Green Warriors and Gardening Clubs of the Primary Department have once again collaborated together. Human activities are damaging our beautiful planet. To talk about climate change is the need of the hour. Small steps taken today will lead to a better future. The students of the Primary Department took an initiative of creating awareness among the masses by presenting a street play on 'Save Environment'. The same was followed by a live worksheet which was attempted by all to learn the practices which help our mother earth to heal.






#### **OTHER MATTER OF SPECIAL INTEREST:**

❖ To celebrate Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, on the occasion of Republic Day, discussion on the National War Memorial was taken up in classes 3 to 5 on 20th January'22. Students were apprised with its significance and encouraged to attempt a worksheet.





❖ With an aim to create awareness among the students about the uncontrolled climate devastation Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi Organization conducted **National School Paryavaran Competition** for the students of classes I- XII from 6th January'22 to 26th January'22. Under this Competition a Class Wise Online Quiz was to be attempted by the students. Students of classes 3-5 actively participated in the competition and received their e - certificates from the host organization.

#### Library Activities:-

To help our young learners develop their love for the beautiful world of books, a number of library activities are being taken up regularly in Classes III-V, which include:-

- ✓ Reading the autobiographies of famous personalities during the Library period, besides watching interesting videos/PPTs about their achievements and writing/speaking about 2-3 takeaways from their lives.
- ✓ Maintaining a Book journal 'My Takeaway' wherein students complete an interesting worksheet on the latest book read by them. They write one famous quote/dialogue of their favourite character and design a new and interesting ending for the story.

### \* Winter Break Holiday Homework:-

Keeping in view the fact that during these challenging times when it is difficult for our students to step out, the Primary Department designed the winter vacation holiday homework in a fun-filled way so as to help our students stay constructively occupied. Each class was assigned an interesting story book which the students had to read. The students also created beautiful Book Jackets (Class V), Book Covers (Class IV) and Stick Puppets (Class III) along with the synopsis / summary of the story read by them. The students were further encouraged to maintain a book journal – 'My Takeaway' writing various interesting aspects of the story read by them, such as – their favourite character, their favourite quote / dialogue from the story, designing a new ending and so on.
