**Class III – English – When Rusty Played Holi:-**

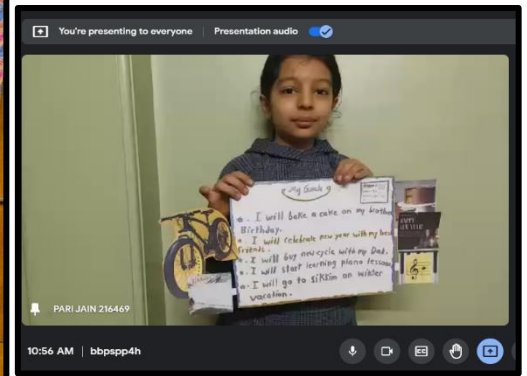
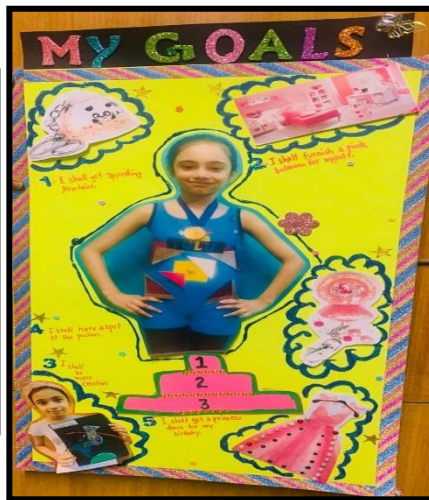
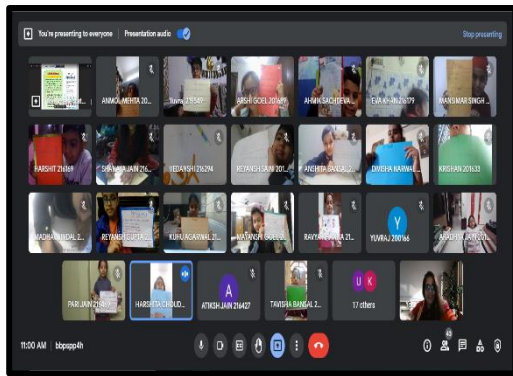

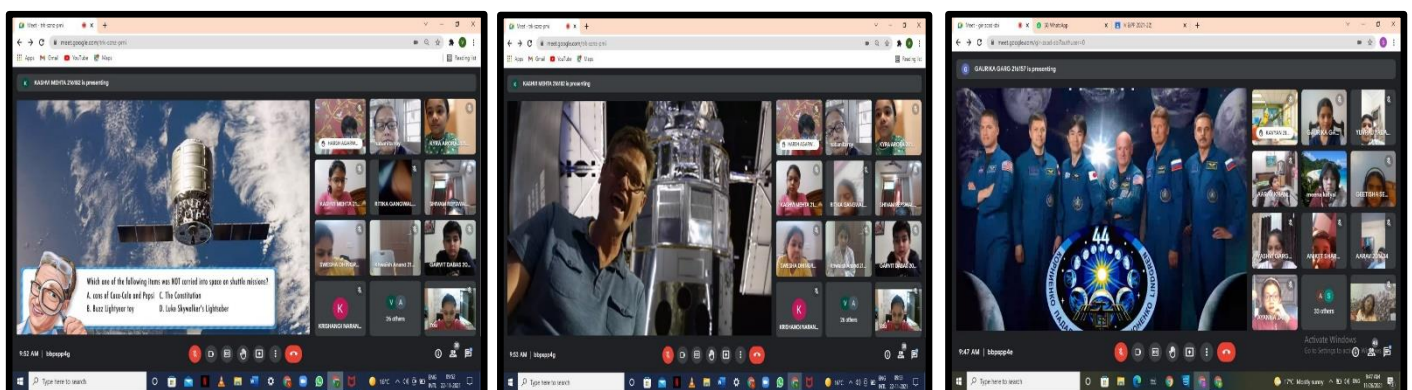
✚ **Class III – English – Chocolate Factory :**

❖ **Happy Morning Mantra:-**

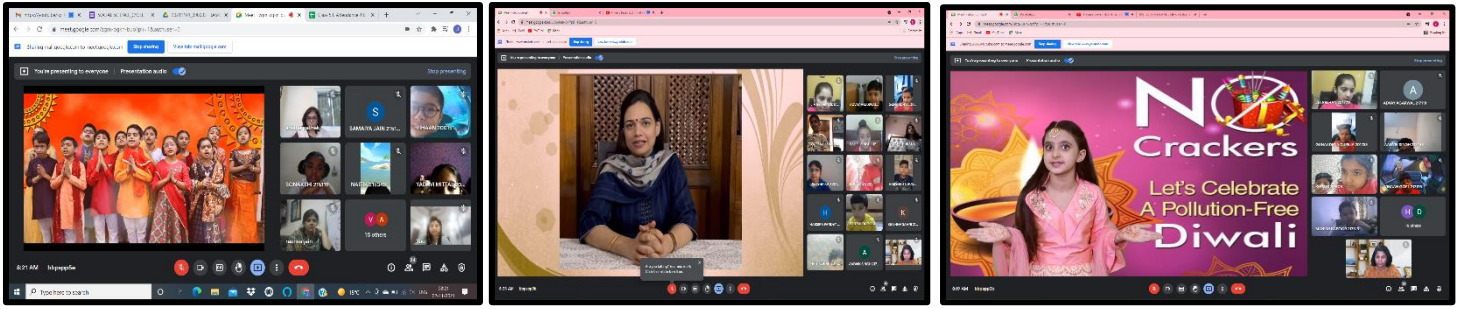
