

children of DRC and thanked God for His blessings. Students were asked to write a letter to one of their friends explaining him/her the difference in the lifestyles followed.











Newspaper in Education:


To make the concepts given in the Science textbook more realistic, a new initiative 'Newspaper in Education' has been started for the students of class V. 
SCHOOL CLUBS - Activities & Competitions:-
