#### **ADAPTATION WEEK FOR PRE PRIMARY (2022-23)**

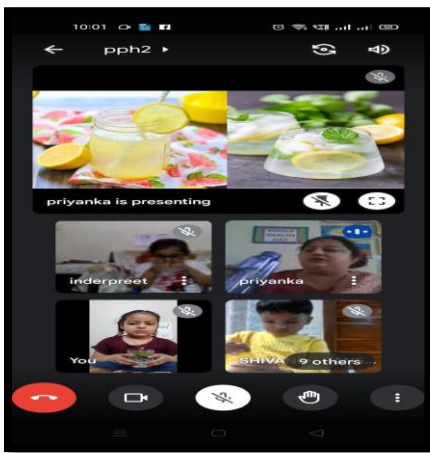
