Interventions For Student Re-Engagement & Dropout Prevention

Care, Connect and Communicate: Personal rapport with the students is required for the teachers to understand the difficulties in their real lives and work on the grassroots level to mitigate the roadblocks in their path to education and schooling. This will require regular PTMs, frequent interactive and counseling sessions with students to gather information regarding their disengagement and identify their needs.

Flexible Learning Options: For the students who are not able to attend the regular classes during the day, can be of great help. An extra class beyond the regular school hours for such children can help in building a strong rapport between the teacher and the students, thereby stimulating their interest in the subject learning.

Project and Skill-Based Learning and use of interesting pedagogies and online tools not only make the teaching/learning interesting in general, but also retain the interest of those children who miss classes due to monotony and lack of new challenges and fun.

Mentor or Guardian Teachers can be associated with such children for addressing academic and social needs, communicating with families and supporting them at all levels with individualized plans to ensure the re-engagement of students.

Students' mental health is directly related to their **social and behavioral well-being**. The same can be assured at three levels—

1. Support at school level
2. Early interventions to identify and address behavioral health symptoms.
3. Intensive intervention through experts in the field.

All said and done, this process is going to be gradual as the students cannot just bounce back from being disengaged for almost two years. There will be a need for transition time and a well-strategized programme to boost the morale of these children who are anxiety-ridden with the fear of falling behind. We, together, will have to facilitate a system to mark a silver lining in the dark clouds which are blocking the path to success for these disengaged students.

When we talk about the casualties of the pandemic, we must not forget children who missed out on so much due to the unprecedented pandemic. Virtual classrooms have undoubtedly tried to bridge the gap in the field of education, but the biggest disadvantage is the absence of a personal connect that seems to have gone down in flames. The students might be interactive on social media but their passivity in online classes cannot be ruled out. This, indeed, is a matter of great concern for all of us, be it educators, parents, or the policy makers. The situation calls for some urgently needed interventions to bring back among students the lost enthusiasm and eagerness for the classes, and most importantly, an urge to attain knowledge.
