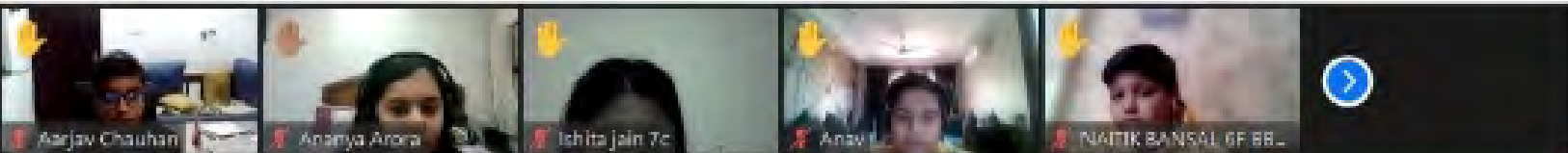






# PINNACLE CLUB

**The school has also extended financial and emotional support to the families of children affected by covid.**

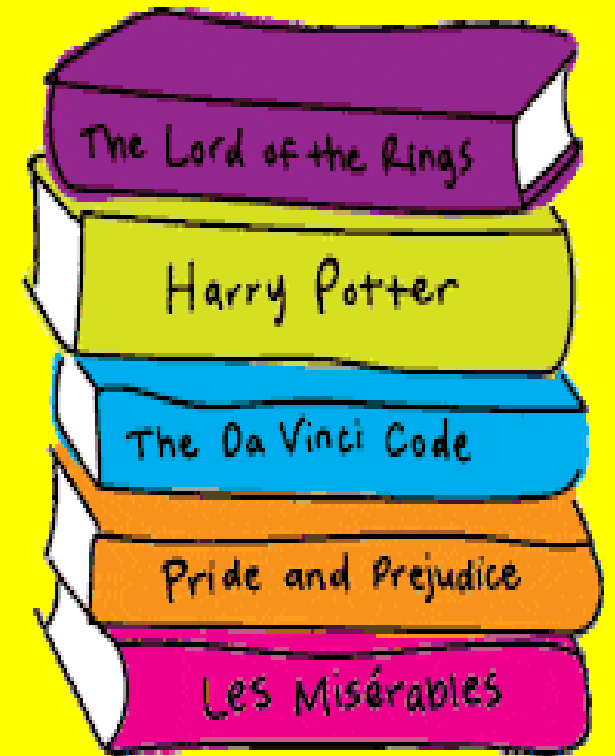
# INTERACT CLUB

# LIBRARY-INITIATIVE

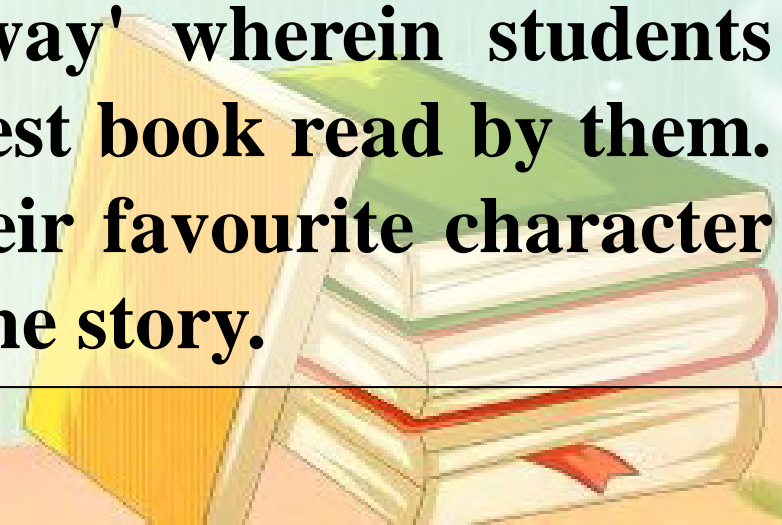

# LIBRARY

**To help our young learners develop their love for the beautiful world of books, a number of library activities are being taken up regularly in Classes III-V, which include:-**

- 1) Reading the autobiographies of famous personalities during the Library period, besides watching interesting videos/PPTs about their achievements and writing/speaking about 2-3 takeaways from their lives.**
- 2) Maintaining a Book journal - 'My Takeaway' wherein students complete an interesting worksheet on the latest book read by them. They write one famous quote/dialogue of their favourite character and design a new and interesting ending for the story.**

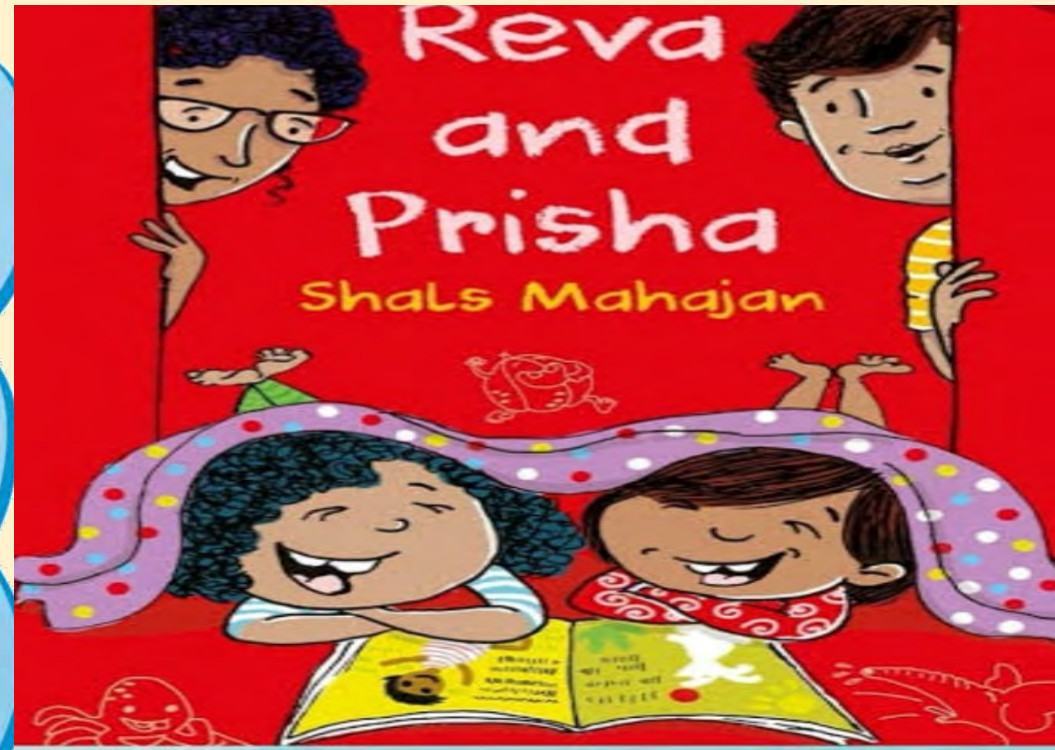
