

The school has also extended financial and emotional support to the families of children affected by covid.



LIBRARY-INITIATIVE

To infuse the joy and spirit of reading in the lives of our students during the vacation time, the Library of the school shared the latest editions of Tinkle and Children's World on the class WhatsApp groups of Pre-Primary to Class V.

To help our young learners develop their love for the beautiful world of books, a number of library activities are being taken up regularly in Classes III-V, which include:-

- Reading the autobiographies of famous personalities during the Library period, besides watching interesting videos/PPTs about their achievements and writing/speaking about 2-3 takeaways from their lives.
- 2) Maintaining a Book journal 'My Takeaway' wherein students complete an interesting worksheet on the latest book read by them. They write one famous quote/dialogue of their favourite character and design a new and interesting ending for the story.



An interesting activity - 'Design a Potato Character' was taken up during the library periods in the Pre-Primary classes. The students used real potatoes and painted their favourite characters on them . They then showcased their creativity and spoke about their favourites.







The Reading Period is held once a week in Classes I-V, wherein the students read a book along with the teacher through screen sharing. Wheelofnames (an online tech tool) is used to randomly pick students to read aloud. Some of the books taken up so far, are:

- The Prince and the Coral Sea by Daisaku Ikeda
- An interesting activity/worksheet is also designed for each book read by the students, to gauge the understanding of the learners and retain their interest.
