An Author Talk was organized by Scholastic for the students of the Primary Department on 30th July, 2021. The author Ms. Arti Sonthalia captured the interest of the students with her engrossing activities and provided them an enriching learning experience.

In order to make the students appreciate the rich cultural heritage of our country, they were encouraged to read mythological tales and seek awareness about the festivals celebrated in India.

For the online library classes, books of renowned authors were selected for the children to read. Information regarding age-appropriate books was shared in the class groups with the students through PowerPoint Presentations.

Online pdfs of Comic books like Tenali Raman, Robinson Crusoe, famous Geronimo series and books on Dussehra and Diwali were also shared with the students on Google classroom. Several fun filled activities like creating comic strips, attempting live worksheets and synopsis writing were designed for the students to enhance their reading experience.
