Prepare to stop at yellow lights and do a full stop at red lights.



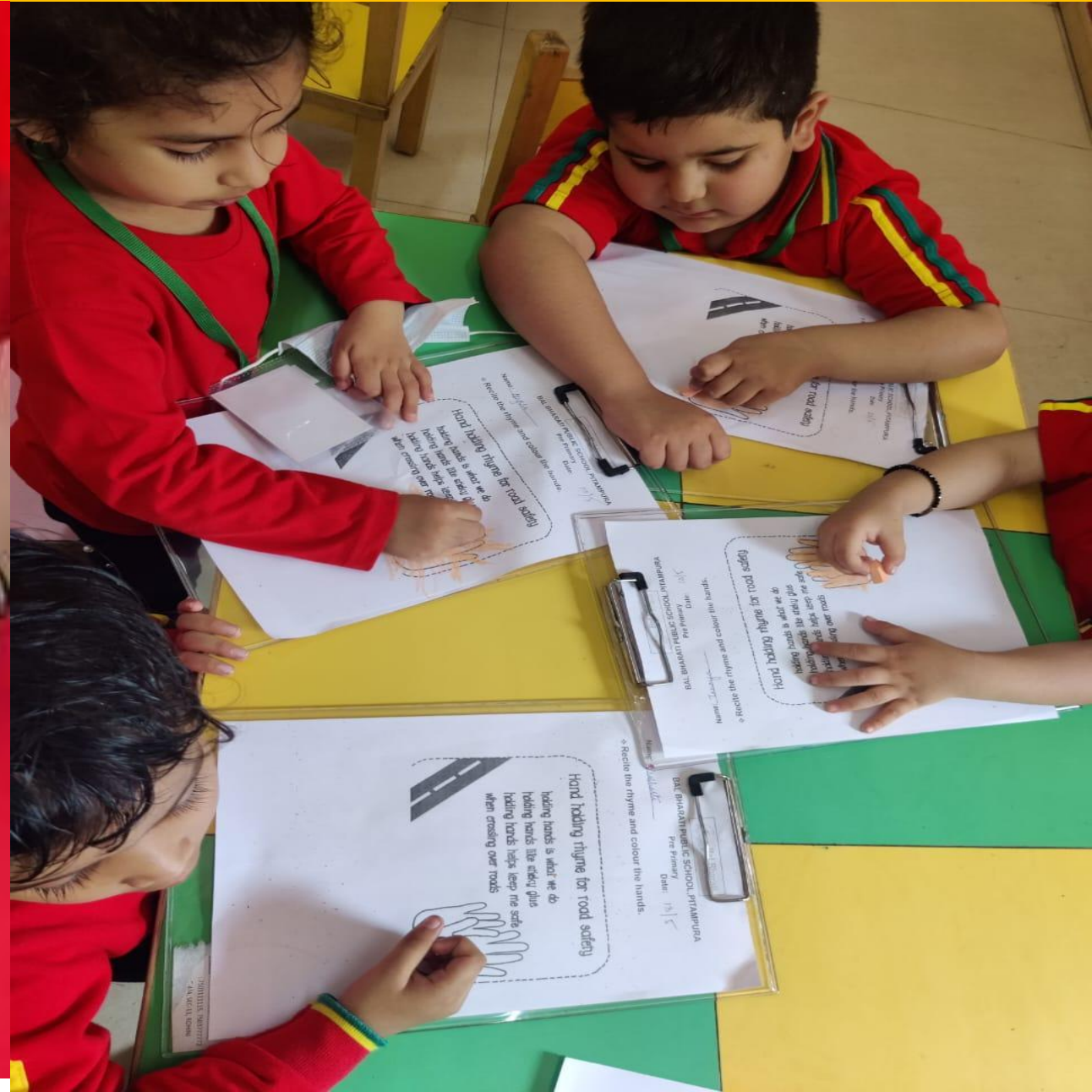
Never drink and drive.

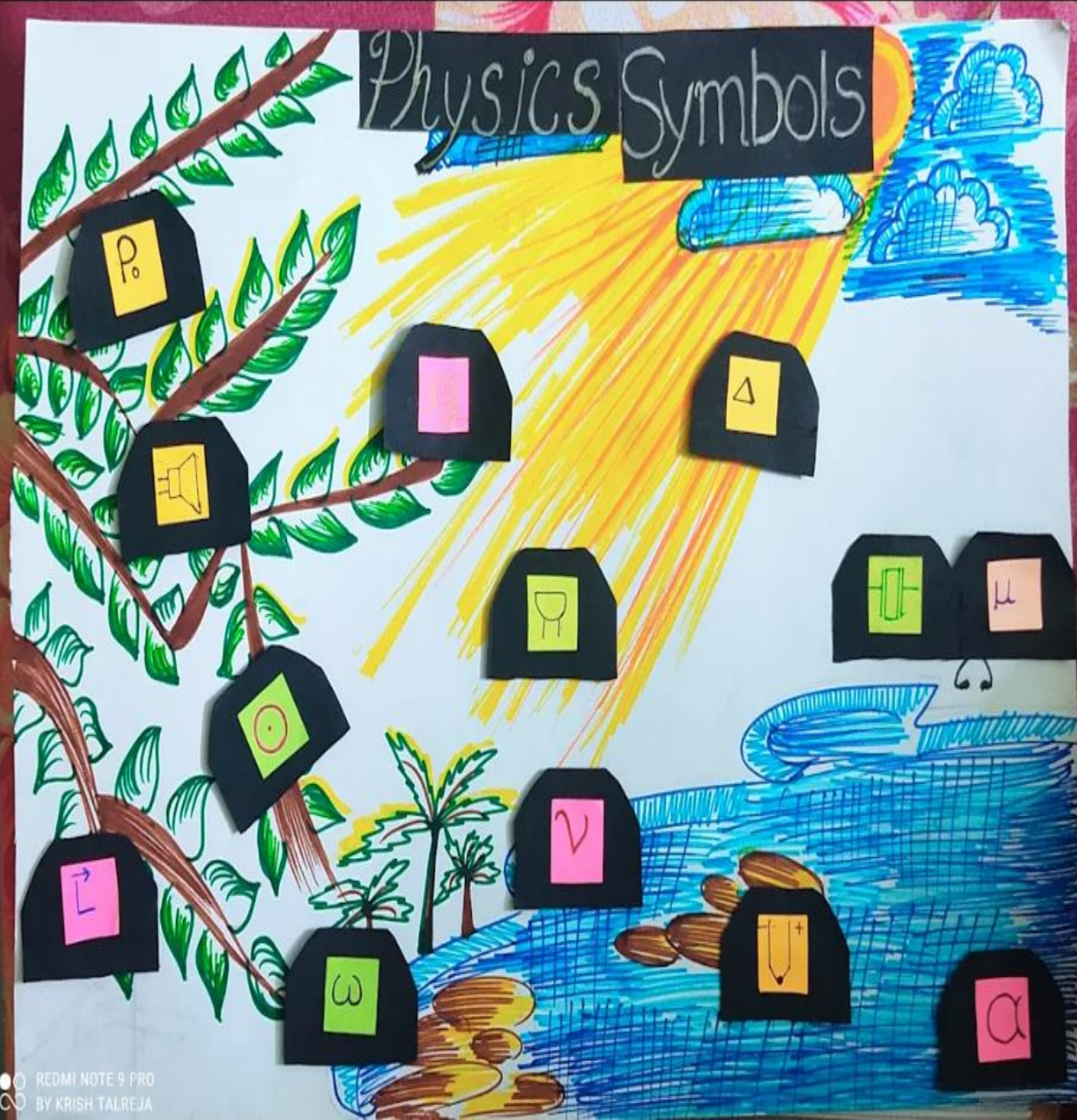

Ananya used descriptive language to share her love for her Barbie Doll with her friends. She could confidently put her thoughts into words.

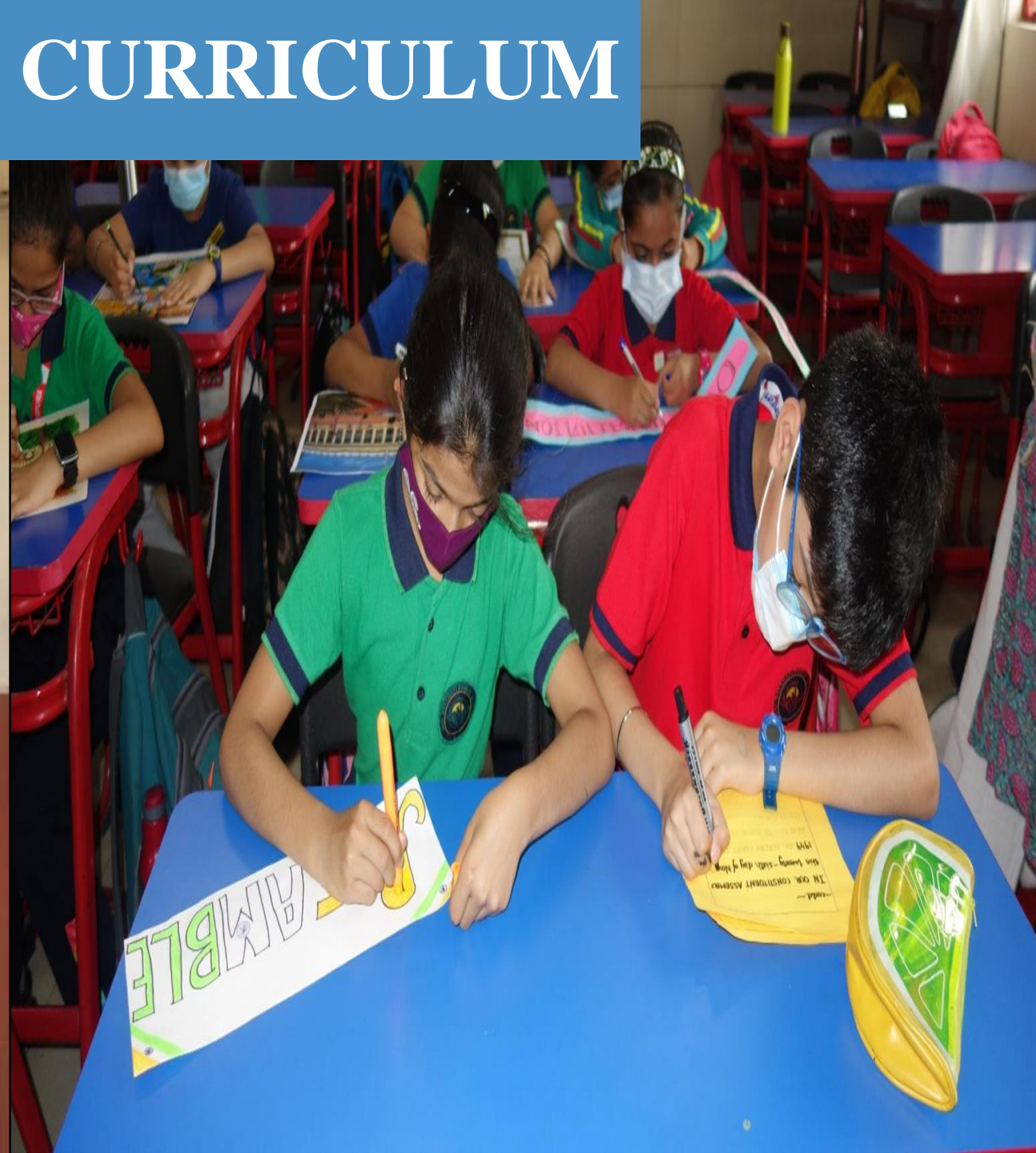
The activity fostered her public speaking skills.
