## 52 cases of dengue in Delhi this year: Civic body

NEW DELHI: Four fresh cases of dengue have been reported in the last one week in the national capital, taking the tally to 52, according to a civic report released on Monday.

Till March 12 this year, 48 cases of dengue were recorded in the city. Four fresh cases were reported in the last one week. As per the civic report on vector-borne diseases, released on Monday, at least 52 dengue cases have been recorded this year. Last year, 9,613 dengue cases, the highest number of cases of the vector-borne disease was recorded in the national capital in a year since 2015, and 23 deaths were reported. The number of dengue fatalities logged in 2021 was the highest in the national capital since 2016, when the officially reported death count was 10.
