INITIATIVES

- ❖ **Elocution: -**

‘Communication is a skill that can be learnt and all it needs is the willingness to do it’. Keeping this ideology in mind, the Elocution Period is held once a week in Classes III-V, with the aim to help our young learners become confident orators and express their thoughts effectively in all scenarios.

- ❖ **Band – Class V: -**

With an aim to inculcate better discipline among our students and help them have a better organised, the Primary Department has initiated Band Classes for the students of Class V. The students attend the same as part of their Zero Period Activity on alternate days.



- ❖ **News Reel: -**

With an aim to give better stage exposure to our students and help them become confident orators, the Primary Department has initiated ‘News Reel’, wherein a number of students from a section present the news on the camera. The same is done every week and has proved to be an effective means towards enhancing the students’ Communication Skills.

❖ **World Earth Day:** -

On account of World Earth Day, various activities were conducted in the Primary Department. Students of all the classes took a pledge to make our environment plastic-free by not using 'Single Use Plastic' and also helping to make others aware of its danger. Students of Class IV, learnt about the problems in the elimination of single-use plastic. A video was also shown to apprise them of the steps which could be taken up at their level in building a plastic free nation. Students of Class V made their friends and family aware of the Eco-friendly alternatives to plastic by designing a poster.
