

#### **SPECIAL INITIATIVES: -**

#### ❖ News Reel: -

With an aim to give better stage exposure to our students and help them become confident orators, the Primary Department has initiated 'News Reel', wherein a number of students from a section present the news on the camera. The same is done every week and has proved to be an effective means towards enhancing the students' Communication Skills.

#### \* Proud to be an Indian: -

The project 'Proud to be an Indian' has also been initiated wherein various modules on the rich legacy of India and the diversity of its culture will be discussed with the students and activities planned thereon. Both these initiatives are being coordinated by Ms. Rekha Sharma, Advisor, Child Education Society.

#### \* Karadi Path: -

To adopt a unique, effective and creative pedagogy for language learning for the students of Class III, Karadi Path programme has been initiated. The programme aims at developing English language programmes after researching and reinventing the way language is learnt in classrooms. A pioneer in publishing audiobooks for children in India for over 20 years, Karadi Path has developed kits and modules for the teachers who are being trained in using the same.

#### ❖ Financial Literacy: -
