### ❖ **News Reel: -**

### ❖ **Western Music – Songs from Across the World: -**

By introducing songs from different countries around the world, the students of the Primary Department are exposed to various customs, cultures, and traditions, enabling them to become a truly global citizen. For the months of April and May 2022, the students learnt 'Malaika'. Malaika is a Swahili song written by Tanzanian musician Adam Salim in 1945. This song is possibly the most famous of all Swahili love songs in Tanzania, Kenya and the entire East Africa, as well as being one of the most widely known of all Swahili songs in the world. Malaika in this context means "angel" in Swahili, and this word has always been used by the Swahili speakers to refer to a beautiful girl.

## SCHOOL CLUBS

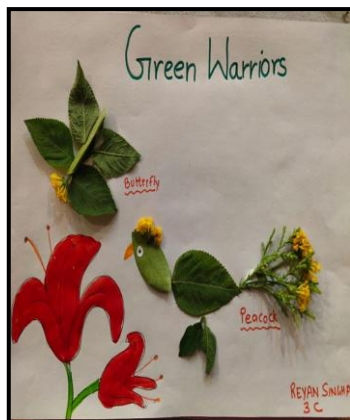
### ❖ Art Club: -
