BRIDGING THE LEARNING GAPS

Since the learners started attending regular school after a gap of almost two years, learning gaps among all students were observed and the need to ‘bridge’ the emotional and academic learning gaps, was strongly felt. With this objective in mind, a Bridge Course was undertaken among all classes in the first three weeks of April, 2022, to prepare the students for the upcoming session. The focus was laid on more written work and the lesson plans were designed with retrospective analysis and emphasis on individual needs was ensured. It proved to be beneficial for the students as it helped them to begin the session with confidence.

WEEKLY LANGUAGE BASED ACTIVITY

In an endeavour to improve the linguistic skills of the students, the English Department has initiated a weekly language based activity to be conducted by the English teachers in their regular teaching periods every Monday.

The activities are as follows:

- Week 1- Speaking (Speech/Poem Recitation)**
