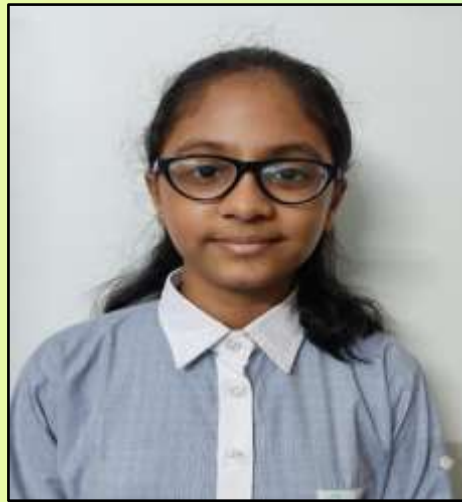
PTM
