- ❖ **Harshit Garg of Class 3 D** has won a number of accolades in Table Tennis: -

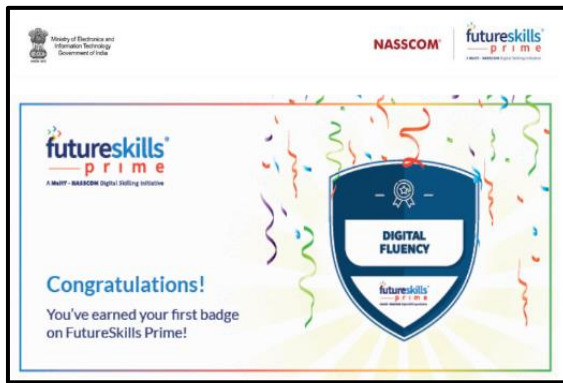

❖ **DOE Activity - Har Ghar Tiranga:** -

Keeping up with the spirit of the day, our school also participated enthusiastically in the same. The students of the Primary Department formed a human flag to commemorate the occasion.



❖ **Tie a Knot:** -

Raksha Bandhan signifies a bond of love, care and protection, and plants are the ones which, from the beginning of mankind, have been showering all love and care upon us. With an aim to instill among its students the virtue of taking care of our beautiful environment and value the gift of nature and taking steps to conserve it, the 'Primary Department', organised a 'Tie a Knot' activity for its students. ❖ **Storytelling Sessions:** -

R.M. Brown has rightly said "Storytelling is the most powerful way of putting into the world today." Storytelling is a universal and traditional art form that is often used as a medium to ingrain values, improving reading skills and opening the minds of children to worlds beyond imagination.
