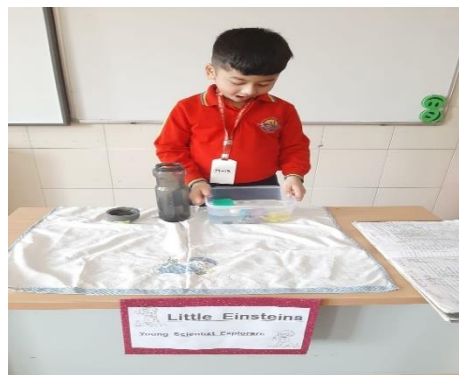
READING CHEER DAY ACTIVITY
