**READING CHEER DAY ACTIVITY**

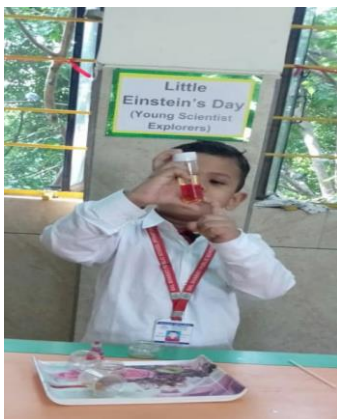
