

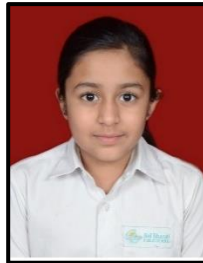


ACCOLADES: -

SPECIAL INITIATIVES: -

❖ **Building as a Learning Aid:** -

With an aim to make learning a continuous as well as fun-filled process, the concept of Building as a Learning Aid (BALA) has been implemented in the Primary Department. As a part of this, different spaces like corridors and staircases have been modified innovatively, thereby converting them into learning spaces. 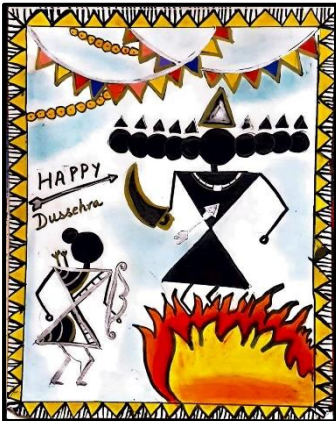
SCHOOL CLUBS - Activities & Competitions: -

- Poster Making Activity



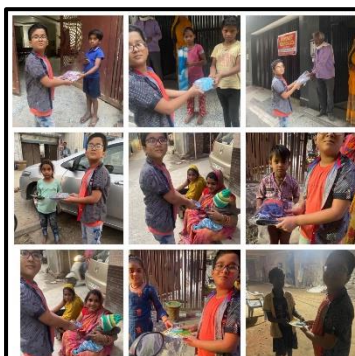
❖ **BBPS Experiential Centre, Solan:** -

❖ **Lighting up Lives on Diwali:** -

Taking its initiative of 'Lighting up Lives on Diwali' forward, the students as well as teachers of the Primary Department pledged to go the extra mile and make the day special for those who are underprivileged. ❖ **Financial Literacy:** -

❖ **Diwali Party:** -

Acknowledging the fact that the students got a chance to be together on one of the most important festive occasions of this vibrant and culturally rich nation after two long years and with an aim to make this time even more memorable for its students, the Primary Department organised Diwali Party on Friday, 21st October 2022. The students decorated their classrooms for the day and enjoyed their favourite food items with their peer group, besides watching a movie. They had great fun with each other and learnt that any day can be made even more special by sharing and caring.



❖ **Karadi Path:** -

To adopt a unique, effective and creative pedagogy for language learning for the Primary students, our school has collaborated with Karadi Path Education Company. Karadi Path develops and oversees implementation of English language programmes evolved after researching and reinventing the way language is learnt in classrooms. The sessions for the same are taken twice a week within the school hours. A specialized kit has been provided to all children enabling them to reinforce the sessions covered in school at home as well. The Karadi Path methodology comprises of four modules, Action, Music, Reading and Story and integrates features of theatre to capture the elements of natural language acquisition. Its non-linear and non-instructional approach allows children to learn English by discovery, by intuition, and by sensory engagement.





Newspaper in Education: -

Moving ahead with its very successful initiative of 'Newspaper in Education', the Primary Department organized an activity - "*Know your Newspaper*" in the Primary classes. Children are encouraged to bring newspapers from home and read the headlines. They maintain a notebook wherein they paste a newspaper cutting of any one interesting piece of news every Tuesday. The students are also encouraged to describe the news in their own words.
