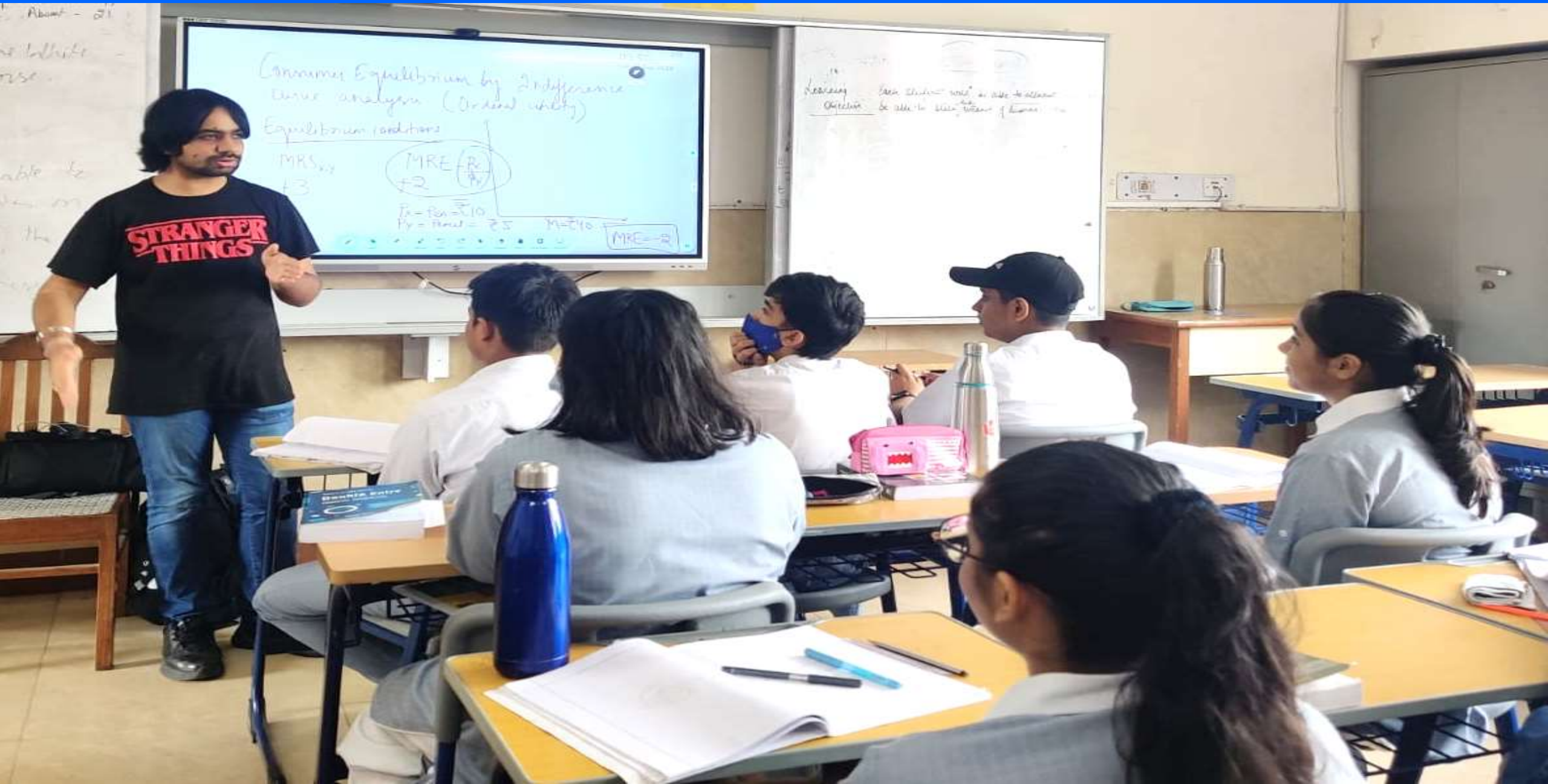




# **MEN AND WOMEN OF SUBSTANCE**
