

Children bring newspapers from home and read the headlines. They maintain a notebook wherein they paste a newspaper cutting of any one interesting piece of news every **Tuesday.** The students are also encouraged to describe the news in their own words.

22 boys and 17 girls of Classes IX and X attended an eight-day training camp at the NCC Bhavan, New Delhi in the month of September. These cadets were given military training in small arms and drill and were required to follow a disciplined routine.

SUSTAINABLE CRAFT




BUILDING AS A LEARNING AID


