## Please note the following with regard to the same:

- 1. The assessments of **GK and Computer** will comprise of only **Objective Type Questions.** The assessments carry a weightage of **35 Marks for Class IV** students.
- The assessments of the Scholastic Subjects will comprise of both, Objective Type and Subjective Type Questions. These assessments carry a weightage of 35 Marks for Class IV students. (Objective Type Questions – 15 Marks and Subjective Type Questions – 20 Marks).
- 3. For the Subjective section: The students will write the answers on blank ruled sheets which will be provided by the school. The students must write the following details on every sheet they use Name\_Class/Section\_Subject\_Date of Exam\_Question Number.
- 4. The time duration for each cycle test will be 1 ½ hours.
