CIRCULAR

Sub: India's G20 Presidency from 01.12.2022 to 30.11.2023 - regarding.

From 1st December 2022, India has become the President of the G20 for the first time which is a historic opportunity for the country. G20 is a premier forum for international economic cooperation representing around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the worldwide trade and about two-thirds of the world population. The Presidency of G20 is a matter of pride for every Indian.

The theme of India's G20 Presidency -

- The theme of India's G20 Presidency - "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" (वसुधैव कुटुम्बकम्) or "One Earth · One Family · One Future" - is drawn from the ancient Sanskrit text of the Maha Upanishad. Essentially, the theme affirms the value of all life – human, animal, plant, and microorganisms – and their interconnectedness on the planet Earth and in the wider universe.
- The theme also spotlights LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment), with its associated, environmentally sustainable and responsible choices, both at the level of individual lifestyles as well as national development, leading to globally transformative actions resulting in a cleaner, greener and bluer future.
- ***The theme conveys a powerful message of India's G20 Presidency, which is of striving for just and equitable growth for all in the world, as we navigate through these turbulent times, in a sustainable, holistic, responsible, and inclusive manner. It represents a uniquely Indian approach to our G20 Presidency, of living in harmony with the surrounding ecosystem.***
- The discussions in G20 are held through two parallel tracks i.e., Financial Track and Sherpa Track. Education is included in Goal 4 of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and is discussed through Sherpa Track.

Activities to be conducted for the students -

- In order to educate and sensitize the school going children about G20 and its significance under India's Presidency, various activities at School/ Zonal/ District and State level shall be conducted by Directorate of Education from December 2022 to November 2023. The Hon'ble LG, Delhi, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Delhi, Hon'ble Dy. CM/ MoE and senior officials/ eminent personalities may be invited to grace the occasion and encourage our students.
- A dedicated G20 Day shall be celebrated in schools of DoE on the day before last working day of every month till November 2023. In the school assembly on that day the achievements/ activities undertaken by G20 under the presidency of India in that month shall be shared with the students. On G20 day one class work / homework activity shall be conducted/ given to the students relating to evolution of G20, India's priorities, other countries' views on India's priorities.
- A special assembly in this regard shall be conducted in the second fortnight of December, 2022 briefing students about G20 and the importance of India getting its Presidency along with details of the year long schedule given below. Videos and pictures of it may be shared on social media tagging Directorate of Education, GNCT Delhi.



- Detailed schedule of month-wise activities is enclosed in Annexure – 1. A separate link will be shared later wherein the photographs, videos, audios related to these activities can be uploaded by respective schools.

Expected Outreach and Outcomes –

- The activities conducted under this theme are expected to touch the lives of all students studying in Schools of Delhi and their families along with all the teachers of Schools of Delhi. These activities are also expected to develop an appreciative outlook among our students regarding:
 - a) The concept of - “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam” (वसुधैव कुटुंबकम्) or “One Earth · One Family · One Future” and the value of all life and their interconnectedness.
 - b) Their association with environmentally sustainable and responsible choices resulting in a cleaner, greener and bluer future.
 - c) Striving for just and equitable growth in a sustainable, holistic, responsible, and inclusive manner.
 - d) Adopting the approach of living in harmony with the surrounding ecosystem.
 - e) Working towards a futuristic, prosperous, inclusive and developed society, distinguished by a human-centric approach at its core.

All DDEs (District & Zone) should visit the schools and encourage the teachers to implement the month wise activity plan effectively. Support from Mentor teachers should be taken to implement this schedule effectively.

Further, all the Heads of Govt., Govt. Aided and Recognized Unaided Private Schools are directed to disseminate this information among students, staff members, SMC members and parents.
