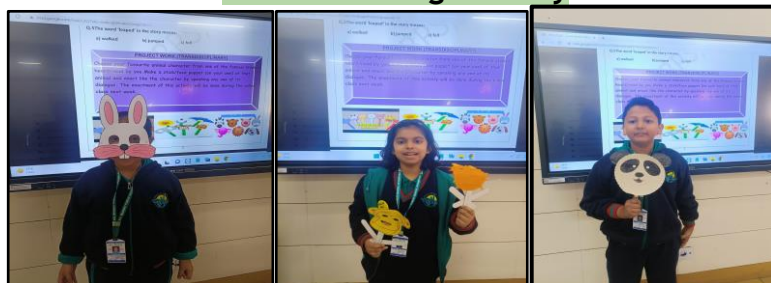

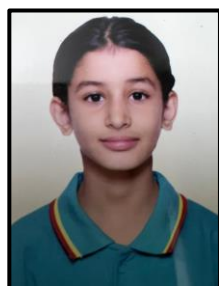
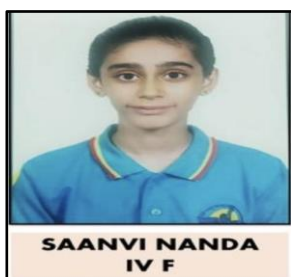

**SPECIAL INITIATIVES: -**

❖ **News Reel: -**

The 'News Reel' initiative of the Primary Department has been going on most successfully since April 2022. It gives better stage exposure to our students and helps them become confident orators, thereby proving to be an effective means towards enhancing their Communication Skills. Students of Classes IV B and V G showcased their talent by presenting the newsreel in the month of November.



❖ **Happiness Curriculum:** -

With an aim to make the teaching – learning process more enriching and the classrooms a happy place to be, the Primary Department has initiated ‘Happiness Curriculum’ across Classes III to V to encourage positive emotions in children. As part of the Happiness Curriculum class, students practise mindfulness drawing, meditation, listen to open-ended value-based stories, laugh together and sing happy songs to enhance their self-awareness, attention span and to improve mental wellness.



❖ The Primary Department organized ‘ **Hunarbaaz’ - Talent Hunt** on 5th December 2022. Many interesting events were planned for the students, such as Walking Vintage, Moves & Grooves, Art Vista, Tech Mavericks, Rising Rockstars, Please Your Palate, Family Fotogenic, Hum Saath Saath Hain and so on. The event was a grand success, which helped in the holistic development of students and also provided a platform to their hidden talents.



❖ In order to make the students aware of the delicacies available in the winter season, a winter fest was organized in class 3I. Students enjoyed eating halwa, laddoos, peanut brittles and much more.



❖ **Karadi Path:** -

Karadi Path develops and oversees implementation of English language programmes evolved after researching and reinventing the way language is learnt in classrooms. The sessions for the same are taken twice a week within the school hours. The Karadi Path methodology comprises four modules, Action, Music, Reading and Story and integrates features of theatre to capture the elements of natural language acquisition. Its nonlinear and non-instructional approach allows children to learn English by discovery, by intuition, and by sensory engagement.

❖ **Art Club:** -
