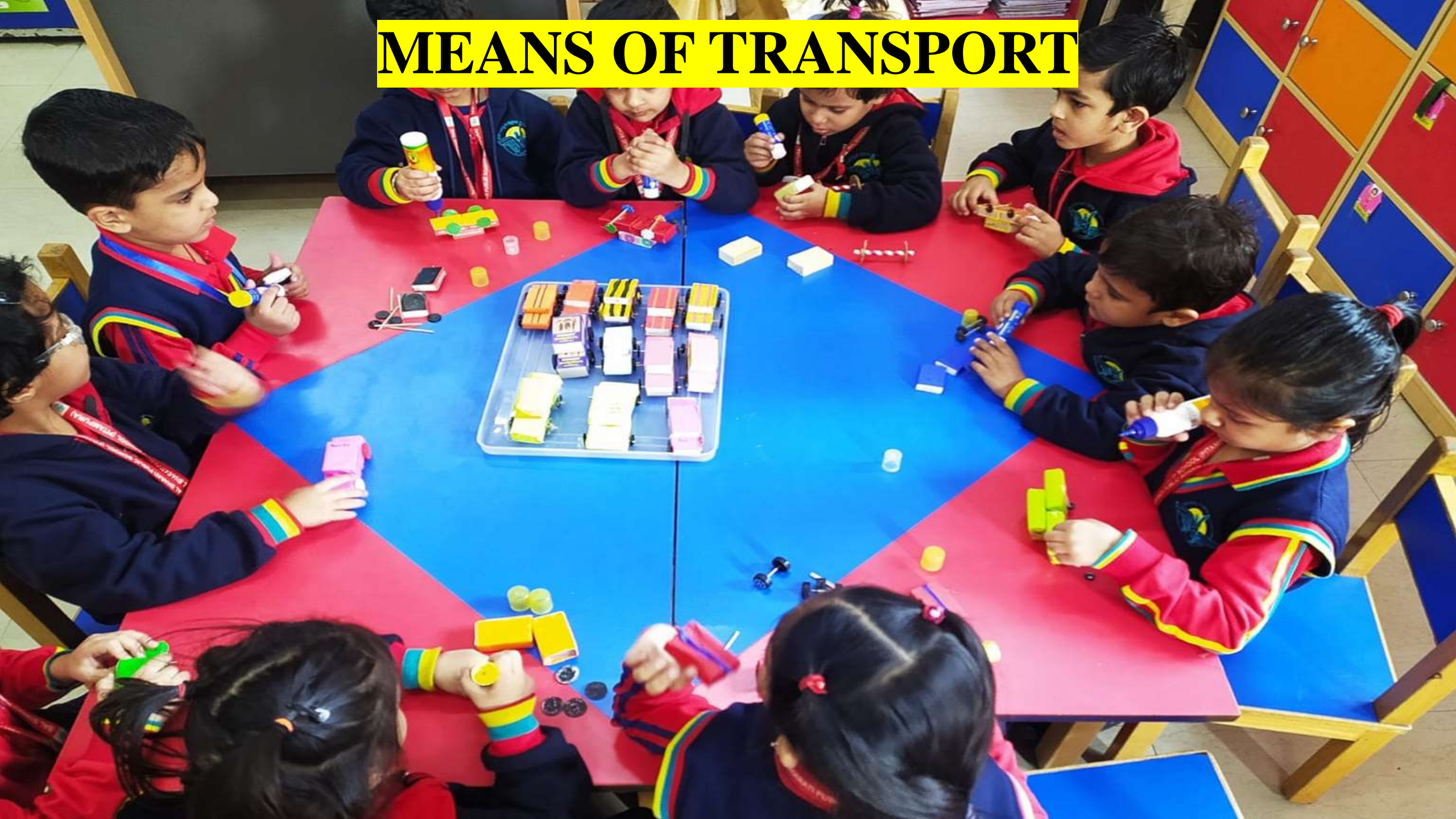


# **TOY PEDAGOGY**
