
CACCOLADES








CITY COORDINATOR




HAR GHAR DHYAN

KARADI PATH

* Karadi Path Programme was introduced this year in PS to Class III. It develops and oversees implementation of English language programmes evolved after researching and reinventing the way language is learnt in classrooms. The sessions for the same are conducted twice a week within the school hours in PS to Classes III. The Karadi Path methodology comprises four modules, Action, Music, Reading and Story. Its noninstructional approach allows children to learn English by discovery, intuition, and sensory engagement. Next year, it is proposed to be extended to Class IV.





HAPPINESS CURRICULUM

Happiness Curriculum was introduced in the Mont. Department. Seeing its effectiveness, it has now also been introduced in the Primary Department. As part of the same, students practise meditation, listen to open-ended value-based stories, laugh together and sing happy songs.

MASS PT

We believe that a healthy mind resides in a healthy body. Weekly Mass PT sessions are being organised for the students of Classes VI-VIII from November, 2022 onwards. Students enjoy activities like aerobics, dancing for warm up, and yoga. It prepares them for the day by enthusing them with positive energy.

They are also encouraged to describe the news in their own words. The teacher also discusses major news items with the students.



PHAD SE PAD

Centre for Cultural Research and Training (CCRT) organised an event on 'Phad Se Pad' in Dwarka, Delhi on 24th January 2023. 20 schools from Delhi/NCR participated in it. A beautiful scroll on Dandi March and Civil Disobedience Movement was created by our staff and students using Phad Art. This was exhibited to the accompaniment of music and a choreographed dance performance by our students.

'Build your Own Compost' has been initiated in Class II * where they make the compost and then use it to nourish our school plants.





SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015, provides a shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future. Keeping this in mind, Classes VI-VIII have been proactive in adopting the SDGs as an integral part of their Class Presentations through the 'Newsreel'. This initiative has provided an opportunity for our young learners to come together, examine, debate and dialogue about the UN's Sustainable Development Goals in an engaging way besides honing their communication skills.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Artificial Intelligence is the need of the hour! The students of Classes III-V were given hands-on experience on 'Quick Draw' - an online game based on Artificial Intelligence developed by Google. The students were challenged to draw a picture of an object or idea which was then guessed by Artificial **Intelligence.





NATIONAL CADET CORPS

Our school became a part of the NCC programme last year to inculcate discipline and honesty among students so that they become able leaders and useful citizens. Our first batch will be appearing for the NCC 'A' Certificate exam in the first week of February. A training session for the same was organised on 21st January, 2023 for NCC cadets to apprise them of various drill aspects and other * theoretical topics like map reading, armed forces, military history, etc.





MENTAL ABILITY

In a world that is brimming with cut-throat competition, it is essential to impart knowledge that sharpens the critical thinking and logical reasoning skills of the students. Mental ability also forms an essential part of almost all admission tests. Keeping this in view mental agility worksheets are taken up across classes VI-XI during the CTP once a week. The answers are discussed with the students, and they are taught simple tips and tricks to deal with the same.



VALUE EDUCATION

Value education is one of the pillars of our education system. Value education classes have now become an essential part of the Class Teacher's Period across all grades. It not only instils good values in the students but also strengthens the bond between the * students and the teachers.





SKILL TRAINING INITIATIVES

MY MENTOR PROGRAMME

The students of Classes IX and XI have been enrolled for 'My Mentor Programme' as part of the Life Skills Development initiative. This is a technology powered skills building and assessment platform to provide affordable access to 21st Century Skills Development. This helps high schoolers to develop their character-based skills like self-awareness, critical thinking, etc., by turning their daily life experiences into meaningful skills-based measurements.

They are currently undertaking the Topic-'Time Management Skills' through engaging modules. The programme is mentored by Mr. Mukund Kumar, Founder/CEO - My Mentor Academy, Boston, USA.

- •Mental Maths through Vedic Maths








THE SCHOOL CONNEXION



My Tree Program


Our school is a part of 'My Tree Program', an initiative by The Satsang Foundation. Following activities were conducted to take this initiative forward:

LITTLE SCULPTURE ACTIVITY


