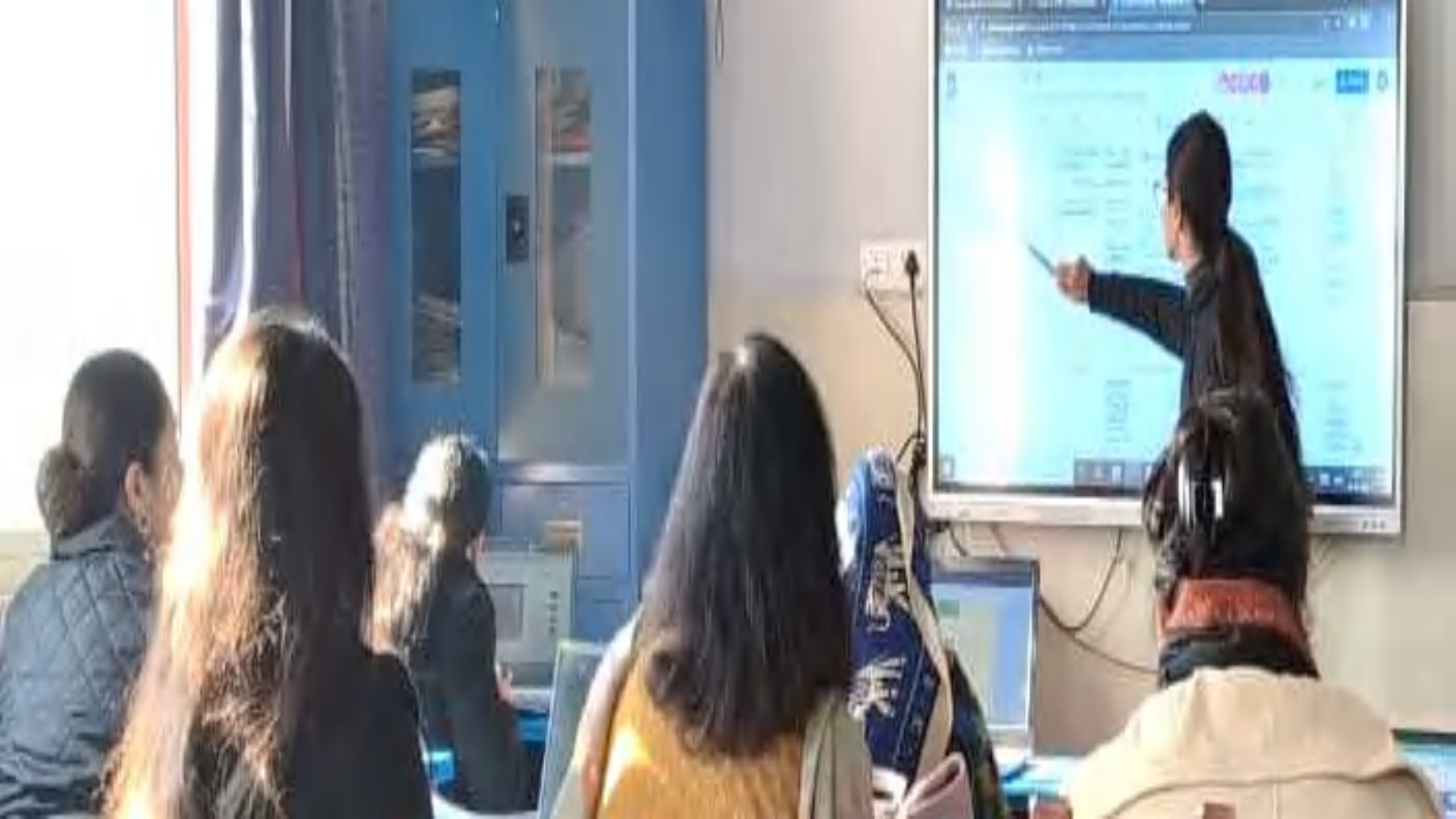

2. Myocardial Ischemia	Reduced blood flow to the heart muscle, leading to myocardial injury and arrhythmias.
3. Ventricular Fibrillation	Disorganized electrical activity, leading to a chaotic and ineffective heart rhythm.
4. Asystole	Complete cessation of electrical activity and heart function.

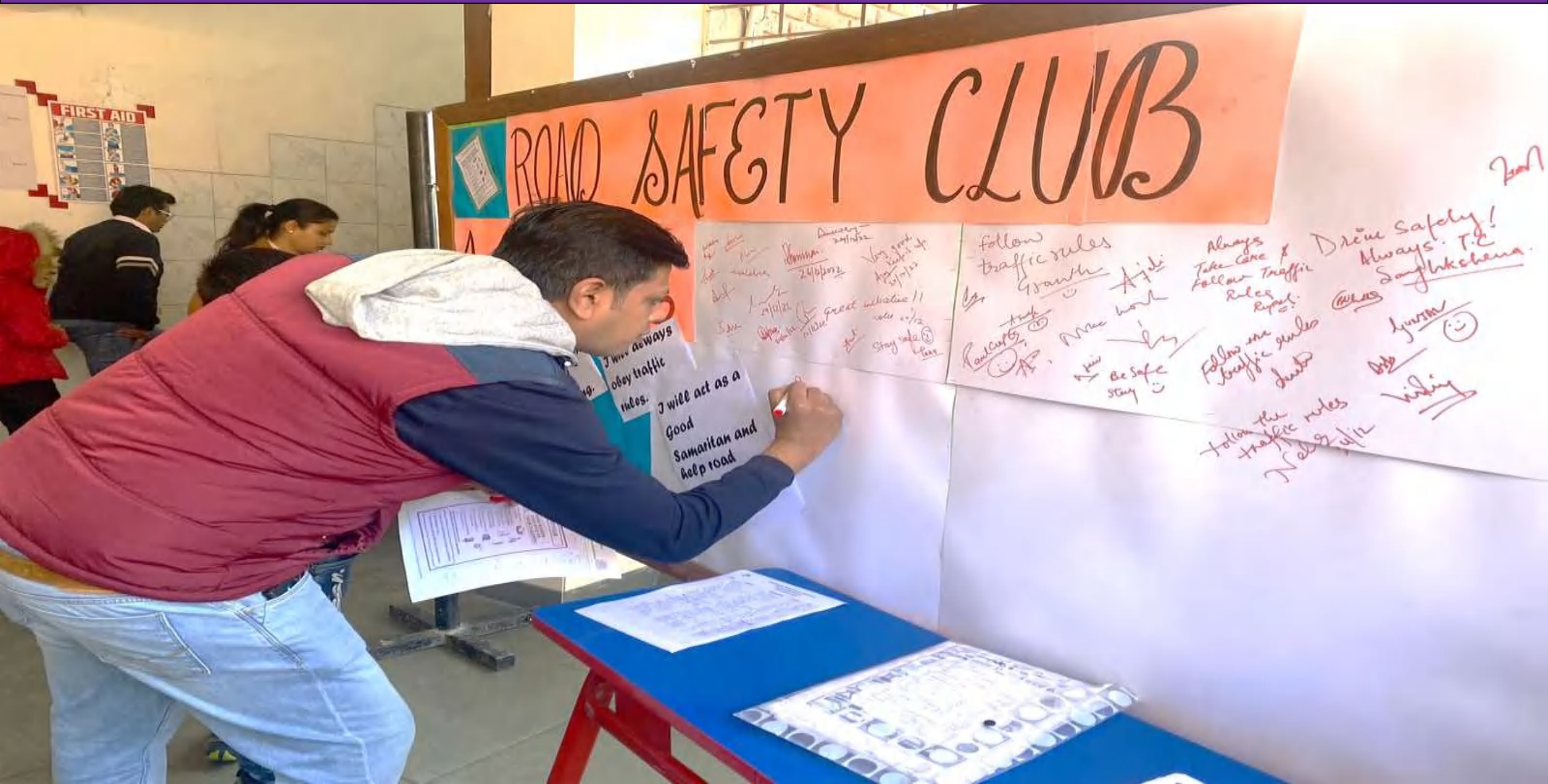
