


It is a moment of pride that for the first time ever, India has become the President of the G20 group. Information related to the same was shared across classes through presentations which were followed by class discussions.

# EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT BHASHA SANGAM






#### EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT

#### **DOE ACTIVITIES**




