**It is a moment of pride that for the first time ever, India has become the President of the G20 group. Information related to the same was shared across classes through presentations which were followed by class discussions.**

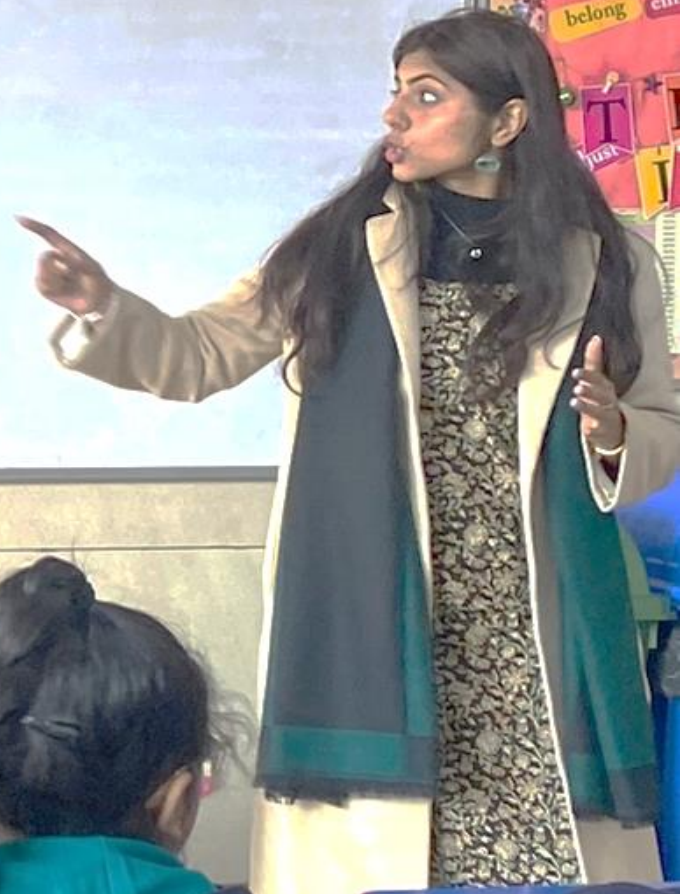
