TASK 2: LETS TRACK NIFTY50

NIFTY 50 is an index consisting of India's top 50 large-cap companies that are leaders in their respective sectors. So, only some of the biggest and most reputed companies in India become a part of this index. And the index is used as a hypothetical portfolio that can reflect the overall movement in the Indian stock market.

The change in the NIFTY 50 that you often see in the news comes from the change in the stock prices of the 50 underlying companies that constitute the index.

- Identify any 5 companies from NIFTY50.
- Track the highest and lowest price of the company stock price on daily basis.
- Tabulate the data date wise in the month of June.
- Plot the data using graphical representation.
- Identify 2 news which affected the stock price of the company.

TASK 3: EXPLORING THE ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS

The Andaman and Nicobar Islands, located in the east of the Indian mainland geographically, float in splendid isolation in the Bay of Bengal. Once a hill range extending from Myanmar to Indonesia, these picturesque undulating islands, islets numbering around 836, are covered with dense rain-forested, damp and evergreen forests and endless varieties of exotic flora and fauna.

The local crafts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands include woodwork and carpentry. Several wooden articles and furniture are sold here. Items made from ornamental wood like chui, paduk and marblewood are quite popular. Paduk burr is mostly used to make tabletops that are a beautiful piece of work.

You are the owner of a Travel company "*Relax and Enjoy*".

- Plan an itinerary for 4 days and 3 nights to Andaman and Nicobar Island.
- Compute the cost per head inclusive of travel, accommodation, sightseeing.
- Make an e-brochure using the art of Andaman and Nicobar Island.

The Arch as an Architectural Symbol- Evolution And Technology

Romans used the arches in a variety of ways: from giant aqueducts to an architectural element in buildings such as the Coliseum at Rome.

In India, there have been signs of arches being used since the Buddhist era (c.4th century BC). Here wandering monks cut out caves in the hillsides and often used the arch as a way to mark the entrance of such rock cut caves.

Using sketching as an art form compare the Ancient Roman Arches with the Ancient Indian arches.

GEOGRAPHY with IP

India's two island groups are very different from one another. Lakshadweep is archipelago of twelve atolls, three reefs and five submerged banks, with a total of about thirty-six islands and islets whereas the **Andaman and Nicobar Islands** consists of 572 islands, of which 37 are inhabited. Explore more about these islands and prepare a travel itinerary highlighting the physical and cultural attributes of the island assigned to you. Your presentation should include:

1. Latitudinal and longitudinal extent of the island group
2. Map of the area
3. Total Area and Population
4. Flora and fauna

5. Distinct physical features
6. Languages spoken.
7. Which aspect of that area interests you the most
