


HOLIDAY HOMEWORK

This year's Summer Holiday Homework is aimed at keeping the spirit of research, exploration, creativity, and analysis alive in the learners. Thus, the holiday homework has the following components:

Kindly make note of the guidelines and submit the holiday homework project file in accordance with these.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Holiday homework is a compulsory students activity aimed at enabling them to work independently and explore, research, and have a sustained learning approach.
- The G20 project and the Art Integration activity, as mentioned above, must be compiled in one file wherein the students are going to use A4 sheets to do their work.
- The students are free to explore and use digital tools such as CANVA to enhance the presentation of their work and attach the printouts in the project file.



- Every week the revision worksheets will be uploaded on the Google Classrooms. Please ensure the submission of the assignments is done in the same week on the Google Classroom itself.
- The project file should be properly covered and aesthetically designed indicating the student's Name, Class, Section, Session (2023-24), and SUMMER HOLIDAY HOMEWORK must be written as the SUBJECT.
- The first page of the file should be the CONTENTS page indicating the tasks/ topics with page numbers. (Page number should be indicated on all the sheets.)
- All the pictures downloaded from the internet must indicate the address of the website.
- The last two pages should be BIBLIOGRAPHY and CERTIFICATE.
 - Bibliography- indicating address of the website, books, journals etc. referred to.
 - Certificate Page- certifying that the entire work has been done by the child himself /herself.
 - A scanned copy of the SUMMER HOLIDAY HOMEWORK project file also needs to be uploaded on the Google Classroom under the TOPIC – Holiday Homework (already created on the Google Classroom).

PROJECT ON G20

The year 2023 is a monumental year as India has held the Presidency of G20, i.e. Group of Twenty countries.

This year the G2O Summit is going to be hosted in India hence it is imperative to be a part of this historical achievement and learn to live the ethos it stands for.

'Vasudhaiva Kutumbkam' - One Earth. One Family. One Future illustrates India's message to the world that – **the world is one family.** Hence, in order to reinforce the idea of a filial existence with all the countries, the holiday homework aims to reinvigorate the spirit of togetherness motivating the learners to research on the selected G20 member countries and also inculcate a sense of *'Janbhagidari'* in adopting LiFE – Lifestyle For Environment (a key agenda of the G20 this year).

The project will help the learners to familiarise with the cultural richness of other countries and get into a mode of introspection wherein they see themselves as " world citizens." The project is also pitched to help the learners develop a comprehensive view of the world wherein they can apply the knowledge gained through the various school



disciplines. The tasks under the project will engage the students in exploring a country's culture and try to critically assess its role as a Global partner in sustainable development. With this view, an EXIT TICKET must be filled and submitted by each learner at the end of the project sharing their insights after undertaking the project work.


