- 5. You may use newspaper clippings.









# 2. POWERPOINT

Click on the DESIGN Tab.




Click on the Slide Size Option and further use Custom Slide Size.






## Choose the options as shown in the picture and click OK

## **SEWA ACTIVITY (Compulsory Activity)**

#### **The Sustainable Bottle Garden**

#### Steps:

- Take a plastic bottle, remove its lid and make holes in the bottle as shown in the video.
- Cut the other end of the bottle partially in such a way that it works as a lid.
- Add soil: Add a layer of soil at the bottom of the bottle.
- Add vegetable peel: Add a layer of vegetable peel on top of the soil.
- Repeat: Repeat steps 2 and 3 until you reach the top of the bottle.
- Add biodegradable materials: Collect biodegradable materials such as:
- a. Fruit and vegetable seeds
- b. Ends of vegetables (e.g., green beans, onions, celery, zucchini, and lettuce)
- c. Fruit cores
- d. Green tops of root vegetables (e.g., carrots, radishes, beets)
- e. Herb stems (e.g., basil, parsley, mint, cilantro)
- f. Fruit and vegetable peels, rinds, and skins
   (Food waste which takes longer to decompose: Citrus fruits, melon, nut shells, egg shells, banana peel)
- Layer the materials: Layer the biodegradable materials with dry leaves or shredded paper.
- Add water: Add water to the container to keep the compost moist.
- Mix the compost: Mix the compost every few days to help it decompose faster.
- Wait for the compost to be ready: Wait for 10-15 days for the compost to be ready.

♣ G20 PROJECT- The G20 is a group of the world's largest economies that meet annually to discuss global economic issues. India is a member of the G20, along with 19 other countries. The G20 summits cover a wide range of topics, including global economic growth, trade, investment, financial stability, climate change, and sustainable development.



The year 2023 is a monumental year as India has assumed the Presidency of the prestigious G 20 group of countries and has chosen the theme of 'Vasudhaivakutumbakam'- One Earth, One Family, One Future.

To enable students to have a better understanding of India's G20 Presidency, the following subject based tasks have been designed, which involve research, clarity, and demonstration of understanding of sustainable energy innovations, financial planning, and the G-20's efforts to promote sustainable development.

<u>SUBJECTS</u>	<u>ASSIGMENTS</u>
MATHS	Collect data about the expenditure on health and education sectors of the members of G-20 as a percentage of their GDP during the period 2020-21 and present it in a tabular form.  On the basis of the data collected, analyse, if in future you have your own startup globally in the field of education or health sector, which two countries will you prefer and why?
SCIENCE	<ul> <li>1. Choose one of the following sustainable energy innovations to research on:</li> <li>Solar Panels</li> <li>Wind Turbines</li> <li>Biofuels</li> </ul>



- Electric Vehicles.
- 2. Research on the science behind the innovation, its production, and its potential for widespread use.
- 3. Estimate the cost of production and the potential for market growth.
- 4. Research on G-20's efforts to promote sustainable energy, such as through the Paris Agreement or Mission Innovation.
- 5. Research on the financial planning strategies to support the use and production of the innovation, such as government incentives for sustainable energy, financing renewable energy projects, and investing in renewable energy companies.
- 6.Write a short report that discusses your findings, including G-20's efforts to promote sustainable energy, the financial benefits and challenges of your chosen sustainable energy innovation, and how financial planning can support sustainable energy use.
