


Refer to the following steps to elevate the presentation of the newsletter:

a. LOGIN in using your google account.







2. POWERPOINT

Click on the DESIGN Tab.




Click on the Slide Size Option and further use Custom Slide Size.






Choose the options as shown in the picture and click OK.

Building a budget for a trip to LAKSHADWEEP & ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS

Planning and budgeting are important strategies to manage your money. This is especially true when you're planning for big events that cost a lot of money.

- * Read the scenario.
- * It's an Individual project; follow the steps to build a budget for the trip.
- * Answer the reflection questions.

Scenario

You have to plan a family trip (4 members) to LAKSHADWEEP and ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS for 5 nights 6 days.

There are 2 adults, aged 35 and 38 years, and 2 kids aged 10 years and 8 years, in the family. You have a budget of **Rs 1, 80,000 (for each destination separately)** to cover the cost of travel, the travel costs at the destination, meals, and other fun and water activities to do.

You can choose the dates in the month of June and type of hotels (minimum 3 star), but you have to show that you'll be able to stay within the budget. Now, it's time to plan and build a budget for this exciting adventure.

Building a Budget

Step 1. Review potential costs

Choose how you'll spend your Rs 1, 80,000 budget, making sure to consider the places you'll visit, meals, transportation, and other water activities. Each of these sample costs are per person, so make sure you calculate costs based on how many people will be going on the trip.

Step 2. Create a budget

Show how you'll use your **Rs 1,80,000 budget** to cover all expenses. Calculate the total cost of each activity by multiplying the cost per person with the number of



people on the trip for 6 days. Then, add the cost of each activity to figure out the total cost for the trip. Destination: Lakshadweep

SOCIAL SCIENCE PROJECT

Every student has to compulsorily undertake one project on <u>Consumer</u> <u>Awareness</u> OR <u>Social Issues</u> OR <u>Sustainable Development</u>

Objectives:

The overall objective of the project work is to help students gain an insight and pragmatic understanding of the theme and see all the Social Science disciplines from an interdisciplinary perspective.

It should also help in enhancing the Life Skills of the students. Students are expected to apply the Social Science concepts that they have learnt over the years in order to prepare the project report.

If required, students may go out to collect data and use different primary and secondary resources to prepare the project.

If possible, various forms of art may be integrated in the project work.

In short, the consumer should be empowered with respect to his rights as a consumer.

Recognizing the importance of Consumer awareness, the Government of India has given certain rights to the consumers so that they can protect themselves from exploitation of the sellers and traders.
