


PITAM PURA HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES 2023-2024 PRESCHOOL

For The Parents

<u>Teach them the importance of daily prayer</u>: Prayer is a powerful tool for children and families to strengthen their relationship with God and with each other.

- Be a Friend: Play games with your child like Ludo, Carrom board or scrabble.
- Explore Nature: Take your child for morning walks, count trees, cars, stones, flowers, etc. while going for a walk.
- Sharpen Memory: Put a few things on a tray show the tray to your child for a while and then cover the tray. Ask your child to name the objects which were on the tray. This activity will help enhancing the memory and vocabulary of your child.

 <u>Children love listening to stories</u>: Read stories aloud to them regularly. Help and encourage your child to talk about the picture books.

Encourage your ward to practice these activities

Learning Outcomes: The child will be able to:

- ✓ Learn by doing.
- **✓** Enhance Eye Hand Coordination.
- ✓ Learn Problem Solving Skills.
- ✓ Become Independent and Gain Confidence.
- Inculcate following 'Life Skills' in your child to help him / her become independent.
 - Buttoning his / her shirt
 - Packing his / her school bags
 - Tying his / her shoe laces
 - Keeping his / her belongings back in their place
 - Laying the table for dinner
 - Filling the water bottles
 - Dressing and Undressing themselves

- Imbibe 'Social Skills' in your child.
 - Greeting with a smile when someone comes to the house.
 - Conversing freely with visitors, relatives coming over to the house.

 - Speaking politely and sharing with friends and relatives.
- Encourage them to take care of "Personal Hygiene" by inculcating the following habits:
 - Brushing teeth twice daily
 - Combing hair regularly
 - Bathing everyday
 - Washing hands before and after meals.

 - Cycling
 - Free play in the park
 - Follow the command touch your toes, run across the park, hop on one foot, jump forward, take big steps, take small steps etc.




- ❖ To develop "Fine Motor Skills" engage your child in activities like:

 - Turning pages of a book
 - Squeezing bath sponges/lemon
 - Watering the plants using spray bottles










Complete the sun by paper tearing and pasting




