Centralised councils and task force committees have ensured all schools adhere to stringent quality standards that are a hallmark of all Bal Bharati Public Schools. Together, these initiatives have nurtured a bespoke learning ecosystem that is effectively equipping students with the knowledge, skills and dispositions that will enable them to participate and thrive in the global economy.

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The school was established in 2012 in collaboration with MBPMPL. With a strength of 500+ students from Preschool to Class XII, it also has on rolls 22 teaching and 6 administrative staff members. Parents had always felt the need for a good CBSE school in the area, and when it was envisaged that a BBPS would be opened here, the idea was welcomed by all. The school has children of all strata - affluent and underprivileged - being taught by well-qualified teachers, and the quality of education is at par with national standards.

Locals whose land had been acquired to build the power plant, were offered free education for their children up to Class X. These were mostly underprivileged students belonging to tribal communities, and one of our key inputs was to equip them with communication and leadership skills. Today, some of our alumni are pursuing higher education in prestigious institutions like the Delhi University and the National Law Institute University, Bhopal.

During the pandemic, we provided hard copies of notes to the students who did not have access to gadgets. Remedial classes, too, were organised for them. The well-planned school exhibitions helped students achieve positions in district and state-level competitions like Quiz, Performing Arts and INSPIRE Awards. Our teachers are trained by resource persons from our apex body, the Child Education Society® as well as the CBSE, throughout the year. The school has received VIPNET's Commendable Club Award for two consecutive years.

The school was set up in 2019, in the Sundargarh district of Odisha, by the Child Education Society® in collaboration with NTPC. Starting with 60 students and 10 teachers in a temporary building, today the school boasts of a full-fledged permanent building as per CBSE norms. The enrollment, too, has increased to 192 students, and the faculty strength to 20 teachers.

At the outset, the school aimed to provide quality education, particularly to the children of the NTPC Township. However, as the school ventures into its fourth year, we have been reaching out to the children of nearby villages, focussing on the development of their cognitive, social, emotional, cultural and physical skills, apart from providing them with high quality academic inputs. We pay special emphasis to character building, personality development, inculcating Indian values and tradition, and preparing the young scholars for life ahead as global citizens.

With instructional aids such as interactive boards and projectors, the school elevates instruction-based teaching to a new level. These interactive classes provide teachers with increased teaching efficiency, and students with more learning opportunities.

Our teachers undergo professional and vocational training from time to time, to stay updated on the latest pedagogical methods and skills. And our students are taken on educational trips to broaden their learning experiences through exploration. They have marked their excellence at various inter-school and district-level competitions.



Established in 2018 in collaboration with NTPC, today the school has 470 students on its rolls, from Preschool to Class XII, besides 21 facilitators and 5 administrative staff.

Before its arrival, despite there being 4-5 CBSE schools within a 25 km radius, there were several challenges faced by the local population in respect of the quality of education. BBPS Gadarwara came with great infrastructure, well-trained faculty, and tech-enabled classrooms. Quality education provided by the school has had a life-changing impact on students and parents. Our focus on holistic development and academic excellence has opened up access to a wide range of opportunities for students, increased their self-confidence and self-esteem, and provided a great teaching-learning experience. This has helped students to become well-rounded individuals and has given them an edge as compared to other schools in the locality.

The school's first batch of board students took the Class X exam in 2021-22, with a 100% pass result. We are also providing them with the necessary support for competitive exams, including textbooks, study materials, past exam papers, tutorials, mock tests with feedback, revision strategy for better retention, and counselling services to help students cope with stress and anxiety.

During the Covid period, we shifted seamlessly to remote learning, employing a wide range of teaching and assessment tools. Located amidst lush surroundings, thanks to the numerous plantations around the campus, we are committed to environmental protection, with initiatives such as efficient use of solar energy that meets our electricity requirement, Matdata Jagrukta Abhiyan, and declaring the campus a No Plastic Zone.

Set amidst verdant grounds of the NTPC township, the school is one of the premier institutions of Bharuch district in Gujarat. Since its inception in 2002, it has expanded to offer education from Preschool to Class XII, and today it has a strength of 474 students and 23 faculty members.

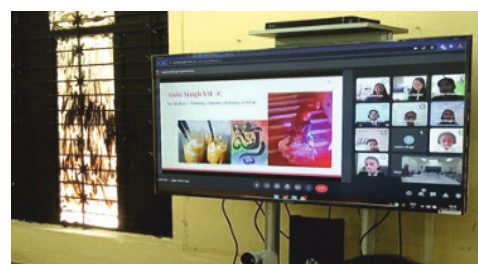
Along with the students of the township, we also act as a facilitator for the first generation learners residing in the neighbouring areas. Our endeavour has always been to harness the talents of each child to his or her fullest potential. We organise special guidance sessions and seminars, to help our students prepare for competitive exams. This has led to great outcomes. For example, Jayant Chandwani (Class XII) is a state topper in the National Standard of Examination in Physics 2022. He earned a position among the top 1% students of Gujarat state.

After completing their schooling, our students have gone on to achieve success in higher education and professional life. Many of them are working with reputed companies, both in India and abroad, as engineers, IT specialists, managers, doctors etc.

Despite being located in a remote area, the Child Education Society® has ensured that the school is equipped with advanced technology and infrastructure. We have implemented best practices like bridge course, remedial teaching, communication skills development programme, e-twinning, horticulture, Google Classroom, and most recently, installation of IIPs.

Till 2013, there was a paucity of good schools in the vicinity, when the Child Education Society® in association with APCPL (NTPC), established this school with the intent of bringing about a positive social change. The school offers quality education up to Class X to 370 students, ably supported by a well-trained faculty of 24 teachers.

Since then, the school has become a reputed name and has consistently undertaken social outreach. One such initiative involves our team of students and teachers visiting nearby villages every quarter, to create awareness about various social issues through street plays, speeches and personal dialogue. We support NTPC's Girl Empowerment Mission (GEM) programme wherein we provide full academic assistance to many girl students from the adjoining villages, and prepare them for a better future.

Recently, the school has tied up with government schools in the neighbourhood, to support the students by teaching them English language skills, and igniting the spark of innovation by giving them access to our Atal Tinkering Lab. The school maintains a fine balance between academic excellence and extra-curricular activities to ensure all-round development of its young students. Besides activity-packed summer camps, Sanskarshala and The Awakened Citizen Programme are organised to inculcate human values in the students.

The school aims to bring quality education to an isolated and remote area, and is the result of a collaboration between the Madhya Pradesh Power Generating Company Limited and the Child Education Society®. Established in 2022, with 297 students from Nursery to Class VI, we are a child-centric entity where uniqueness of every child is recognised with the intent of nurturing them into becoming their best versions.

In line with the National Education Policy, we strive to provide experiential and holistic learning through various concept/activity/skill-based methods in smart classrooms, through the use of multiple age-appropriate teaching-learning materials. Special assemblies celebrating various international days, National Library Week, STEAM Exhibition, subject enrichment activities, parent and student orientation sessions, annual day, sports day are some of the activities organised through the academic year.

We are a future-ready school in a rural setting, where we prioritise life-skills, character building, empathy and compassion, and an amalgamation of traditional and progressive value-based learning. Sessions on yoga, pranayama, meditation, Om chanting, stress management, and enhancement of self-awareness are conducted from time to time. The school also made its presence felt globally by attending a virtual World Children's Day Upschool Conference wherein primary school children from all over the world showcased their case study projects. We have invited guest speakers from the UK, Australia and Qatar, to help us imbibe the nuances of global citizenship.

This young school has an innovative and energetic team of academic and administrative staff, and we are working towards getting CBSE affiliation at the earliest. The school has successfully ventured into its second academic year and has now opened Class VII.



The school was set up in 2018, at a time when not a single CBSE school was present within a radius of 35 km in this rural area. Our main achievement has been getting students from among tribals and villagers. The girl students who were adopted, as per the initiative of NTPC's Girl Empowerment Mission, have been mentored regularly on aspects of hygiene, communication, etiquette and social interaction, going beyond academics. Through various mentorship programmes, these students are given special attention and groomed, to enable them to be at par with the rest of the class. We undertake e-home visits regularly to counsel parents of children who belong to such groups.

Our students have been part of community participation efforts to help villages become self-sustained. They volunteer to educate the adult community by visiting nearby villages, to spread awareness about health and hygiene, by making and putting up posters, staging *nukkad nataks*, and distributing healthy food packets to the underprivileged.

Along with the students, our teachers also call upon the village girls to enhance their computer skills, under the umbrella of 'Each One Teaches One.'

Instead of schooling being restricted to the pages of books, the facilitators here engage with the community for its betterment. To help the students of the village government school with their Class X board preparations, our teachers took extra classes after school hours, under the umbrella of 'Reach Out to Teach.'

There may be scarcity of materialistic things in the surrounding area, but the fragrance of education is slowly and steadily spreading all around.

The school was established in 2018, under the aegis of the Child Education Society® in collaboration with NTPC. It offers education up to Class X, and has an enrollment of over 306 students. The faculty comprises experienced teachers who are committed to providing quality education and ensuring that no child is left behind in the region.

The lack of good schools in the vicinity posed a major challenge earlier, as many local residents were forced to send their children to far-off cities to pursue their studies. Apart from being extremely inconvenient, this posed a significant financial burden for many families, and often resulted in students dropping out of school due to the high cost.

The arrival of BBPS changed the education landscape, and our school became a beacon of hope for families in the region, providing a reliable and affordable option for quality education. For students and their families living in Muttagi, Kudgi, Basavan Bagewadi, Golsangi, among others, it transformed their lives and provided them with new opportunities. The school is committed to continuing its legacy of excellence, and to contributing to the overall development of the region and the nation. On their part, the parents are keen on the school starting Classes XI and XII as well.

The school's journey began in 2019. Earlier, the local residents explored alternatives for their wards, far away from home. But after the opening of BBPS, they retraced their steps back to this rural yet cosmopolitan school.

The school has fostered the love of learning in our students, and encouraged them to try out new and exciting things. It is no wonder that the enrollment that started at 40 students is now nearing the 300 mark. The school has achieved milestones that have elevated the standards and spirits of the school, namely Best Team Award in the Inter School English Debate Competition organised by Aryavrata Sahodaya, featured in the INSPIRE Award Scheme, displayed exemplary performance in different Olympiads, Silver Zone and DSSL. Our student, Saanvi Bastia, cleared two English Olympiads and Wara Ahmad secured the third position in the state. We have also secured first positions in intra-district Kabaddi and Kho Kho.

We have been providing enrichment and improvement classes, and preparing students for Olympiads. The best practices include aashirwad ceremony, Satraarambh Yagna, educational trips to places like Bodhgaya, inviting local artists and craftsmen to increase students' interest in Indian heritage and culture, sessions with a child psychologist on the Mental Health Day, and focus on experiential learning through curricular and club activities.

Established in 1993, by the Child Education Society® in collaboration with the Indian Railways, today this school has 1,274 students and 40 teachers.

The school aims at sustaining an environment that enables students to excel in scholastic activities, demonstrate superior learning, and develop capacities and skills that prepare them for service to the society. We provide them with rich learning experiences, so that they can value the wonders of this world. At the same time, we train them to learn-unlearn-relearn, so that they are always open to new knowledge and inherit a love of ideas.

The school has classes from Preschool to Class XII. From being a remote location with few facilities, our infrastructure has significantly improved over the years, and now we are one of the top-ranking schools of Bhopal. The school is a boon for the residents of the Railway Colony, as most of the localities in this area house *khalasis* (labour class) working in the Railways. For these parents, having their kids study in an English medium school used to be a far-fetched dream, till BBPS arrived. Today, many of our students are doing extremely well, and it will not be an exaggeration to say that BBPS Nishatpura has brought about a revolutionary change in the lives of the *khalasis* of the Indian Railways.



We are highly supportive of our senior students, arranging special classes to help them prepare for competitive exams, and conducting seminars and workshops for them to enhance various skills. Smartboards and interactive panels have been installed to aid better teaching and effectively engage the young learners.

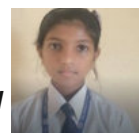
Integrating technology

When it commenced operations in 2006, the school had just 80 students on board, guided by the mentorship of 13 faculty members. We have always embraced innovative practices in ICT to personalise learning beyond books. We work on a broad spectrum of specialist programmes that include physical education, visual arts, skill development, and communication skills. We also endeavour to enhance learning outcomes through different art-integrated activities, supported with new-age skills and comprehensive pedagogical approaches. All these measures have helped build trust in the minds of the local residents, in raising their children as Bal Bharatians.

Over the years, our teachers have taken up numerous challenges to evolve best practices to facilitate a conducive learning environment. From a regular zero period that ensures optimum involvement in activities, to remedial sessions that enable every learner to grow, English-enrichment activities that provide confidence, smart classrooms that have made the teaching-learning process seamless, inspirational morning assembly that induces optimism within the pupils, and more. The Child Education Society® conducts regular training programmes to streamline our focus towards foundational literacy and numeracy, and has guided our faculty in adopting child-centric techniques to face board exams. They have also organised training sessions to strengthen the school website and IT infrastructure, and for the implementation of AI-enabled tools in the classrooms.

The school was started in 2000 by the Child Education Society® in a joint venture with NTPC. Located in the NTPC township at Simhadri in the state of Andhra Pradesh, today we have 421 students, and 18 experienced and well-trained teachers to guide them.

With the aim of upgrading competencies of our students, every year our students are encouraged to participate in over 20 competitive exams conducted by various organisations. Many of our students have brought laurels to the school at international level. The AISSE 2022 result, too, offered a validation of our efforts, with 100% of our students clearing the exam in first division.



We are focussed on making our students tech savvy, and enhancing skills that are essential to thrive in today's fast-evolving world. Clubs like the Environment Club, Literary Club, Science Club, Performing Arts Club, among others, regularly conduct meaningful activities for students to engage them beyond academics.

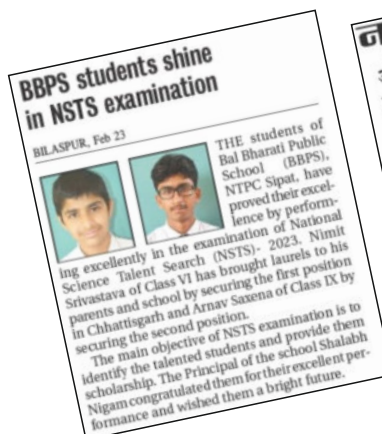
Around Simhadri, many village children are first generation learners who come from socially disadvantaged and economically weaker sections of the society. The school has been instrumental in bringing about a transformation in their access to quality education, and consequently, their lives. For instance, we support NTPC's Girl Empowerment Mission, where 10 brightest girls from underprivileged families living in nearby villages, are selected and given admission into Class VI. To non-NTPC students, CES offers sports scholarship. The school has produced 17 national level players during 2022-23, in Athletics, Martial Arts, Football and Rope Skipping.

The school always strives to inculcate good values among children through initiatives such as Being Truthful, Being Heroic, Pathways of Awakening, and positive engagement through the Awakened Citizen Programme of the RK Mission.

The school was established in 2006, by the Child Education Society® in collaboration with NTPC at Sipat, in Bilaspur district of Chhattisgarh. Today, we have a student strength of 1,017 studying in classes ranging from Preschool to Class XII, and staff numbering 44. The school is a member of the prestigious National Progressive Schools Conference, and has been awarded the ISA by the British Council twice.

BBPS Sipat has had an extraordinary impact on its surroundings. Before its arrival, the area around Sipat had no access to quality education. Today, we cater to children even from far-flung areas. We provide mentoring classes to help students prepare for competitive exams. The results are there to see, and every year our students are joining IITs, NITs, medical colleges, and other reputed institutions. They are not far behind in sports and have played at the state and national levels.

To render service to the community, under Project Happiness, our students and staff visit old age homes, orphanages, and help students of a nearby village. We are also nurturing a few village girls under NTPC's Girls Empowerment Mission. We organise bag-less days and days dedicated to SPIC MACAY, to help students explore a world beyond the classroom. To develop entrepreneurial skills, we conduct the project, Teach A Man To Fish, and to inculcate honesty and integrity, we have opened the Honesty Shop and run the Awakened Citizen classes. In spite of being in a remote location, every class in the school is a smart class now, and there is a STEM lab along with a FUNTOOT maths lab.

Nurturing resilience and excellence



Located in the peaceful and serene environment of the lower Shivalik hills in Himachal Pradesh, 20 km away from Solan town, the school was established in 2012 with only a Montessori wing having four students on its rolls. Today, we have over 200 students, a well-trained teaching faculty, and are supported by a competent administrative team. The school plans to become a residential school from the academic session 2023-24, along with offering day school facilities.

Earlier, the local students seeking quality education had no choice but to go far away from their homes. Now, having BBPS located nearby is a boon for the young learners. We focus on helping our students to develop well-rounded personalities and good communication skills, with a mix of academic inputs and a wide range of physical and co-curricular activities. Parents feel happy that their wards are being groomed as per their expectations.

BBPS Solan is an Experiential Learning Centre for all Bal Bharati Public Schools pan-India, aimed at providing both students and teachers with unique facilities and enriching programmes created by the Child Education Society®. We impart education using a collaborative approach and child-centred methodology in the classrooms. We adopt best practices by participating in activities like the International Humanity Olympiad, HIM COSTE, Students Olympiad Foundation, state-level painting competition, to imbibe the right values and a competitive spirit in our students.

The school has classes up to the secondary level, with our first batch of Class X students appearing for the CBSE Board examination during the academic session 2022-23. We are taking necessary steps to become a senior secondary school in the coming years.

We have overcome any handicap of being remotely located by employing quality teachers, setting up state-of-the-art infrastructure, ICT integration, and building well-equipped laboratories. No wonder, today we have students joining us not just from the upper belt of Himachal Pradesh, but also far-flung areas.

CASE STUDIES

How our core schools support the spread of quality education - in their vicinity, and across remote locations.

1 BBPS GANGA RAM HOSPITAL MARG, NEW DELHI

This was the first school to be set up by the Child Education Society® in 1944, and it has gone on to receive many recognitions. Among them is being ranked No.1 for the 4th consecutive year in Central Delhi, in the Times School Survey 2022. By empowering its students with not just knowledge and skills, but a strong moral and ethical compass, the school has prepared them to build a more inclusive, compassionate, and sustainable society. Its success has inspired many more Bal Bharati Public Schools to be set up, not just in Delhi-NCR, but also across the remotest corners of the country.

We promote diversity and inclusion through various support mechanisms for children with special needs, and those from economically weaker sections of the society. During the Covid period, teaching and learning could continue uninterrupted for all, including the EWS students for whom handsets were arranged by the school. We also extend the use of our excellent sports infrastructure to the neighbourhood community through our Evening Sports Academy, Summer Camp etc.

We provide opportunities for students to participate in projects to spread literacy, promote digital acumen among underprivileged students, create awareness about organ donation, and for fund raising and collection drives for NGOs, relief operations, among others.



2 BBPS PITAMPURA, DELHI

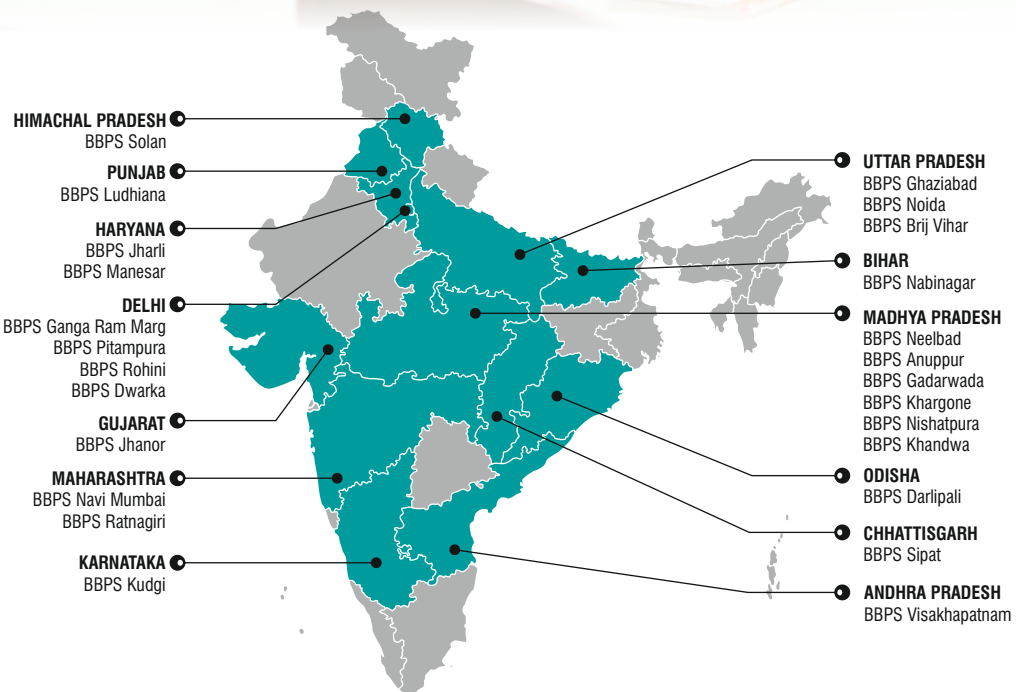
Since 1984, the school has provided quality education through its state-of-the-art infrastructure, at an affordable cost, thus impacting the lives of over 6,000 students every year.
