❖ CACA LIFE SKILLS

Bal Bharati Public school is organised an offline training and workshop for the Parents of Children with Special Needs by Ms. Neha, Mental Health Care Psychologist and Pooja Sharma, Clinical Psychologist on the topic **Unlock your Child's Inner Superhero** on 7th October, 2023. The session for parents emphasized the crucial role of play in a student's development. Presenters highlighted that play is not just fun but a vital educational tool. It fosters creativity, problem-solving skills, and social interaction. By engaging in imaginative play, children develop cognitive abilities, such as critical thinking and decision-making. Moreover, play helps reduce stress and anxiety, improving overall well-being. Parents were encouraged to provide unstructured playtime, limit screen exposure, and create a safe, stimulating play environment at home.





WORKSHOP

The session on road safety and personal safety for Classes 3 and 4 taught essential road safety rules such as looking both ways before crossing the road, using pedestrian crossings, and wearing helmets while riding bicycles. The students also learned about the importance of wearing seatbelts in cars. Additionally, the session emphasized personal safety by teaching children to stay away from strangers, not to share personal information with anyone, and to inform a trusted adult if they ever feel unsafe. This interactive session helped the young students understand the importance of staying safe on the road and in their daily lives.

The session on bullying and body shaming taken up with Class 5 aimed to create awareness about the harmful effects of bullying and body shaming. Students were taught to identify different forms of bullying, such as verbal, physical, and the importance of reporting incidents to adults. They also learned about body positivity, respecting differences, and embracing their own unique qualities.
