- 2) Topic What exactly is the subject or topic of the book? Is it clearly articulated? Does the author cover the subject adequately? Does the author cover all aspects of the subject in a balanced manner? Can you detect any biases?
- 3) Evidence How does the author support his/her argument? What evidence does the author use to prove his/her point? Is the evidence based on an appropriate application of the method chosen to gather information?
- 4) Structure How does the author structure his/her argument? Does it follow a logical order of analysis? What are the parts that make up the whole? Does the argument make sense to you? Does it persuade you? Why or why not?
- 5) Take-aways How has this book helped you to understand the research problem? Would you recommend the book to others? Why or why not?
