- 2. Subject of the Book: What's the book all about? Is it explained well? Does the author talk about everything needed to really cover the topic? Is everything presented fairly, or can you tell if the author prefers one side over another?
- 3. Your Learning: How did the book help you understand the topic it's about? Would you tell other people to read it? Why or why not?

Chronicle Your Thoughts!

Create a routine of reading newspapers daily. Maintain a newspaper scrapbook by putting together interesting articles, creative advertisements, comic strip series, and standalone photos published in the newspaper.





Material Required:

- A4 sheet for recording observations
- Measuring tape or ruler

Project Details:

- 1. **Exploration:** Students are to observe their environment and identify where math is used or visible. For example, finding symmetry in buildings, measuring ingredients in cooking, or spotting geometric shapes in nature.
- 2. **Documentation:** Record any 10 observations with a description, a drawing, or a photograph. Include measurements, calculations, or any mathematical process used.
- 3. Compile all observations into a comprehensive report in a scrap file or digital presentation using Canva / PowerPoint (6-7 slides).



	Giuseppe Arcimboldo is an Italian Renaissance painter known for his portraits of people that use objects like fruit and books.	
	Create Arcimboldo-style portraits or shapes of objects or any image of your choice by combining easily available different images or plant parts (preferably dried) such as flowers, leaves, fruits and seeds on an A3/A4 size sheet.

	paste along with the image created using this art form. Roll no. 26-till last: Design Thinking: My Own Mandala	
	Mandalas have been around for thousands of years and are highly structured forms of art that use repetitive patterns. The word mandala comes from the Sanskrit word for circle, but mandalas can also be squares or a combination of squares and circles. Creating mandalas can help you relax, focus, and reflect.	
	Search and pick up things that capture your eye, like fallen leaves, sticks, and flower petals (preferably dry). You can also collect some waste objects and recycled material and use these objects to create a unique tangible or physical Mandala on an A3/A4 sheet of paper.	



Remember to get your pictures clicked at each step; starting from creating a rough design, and its outline, material selected and applying it to form an image.
