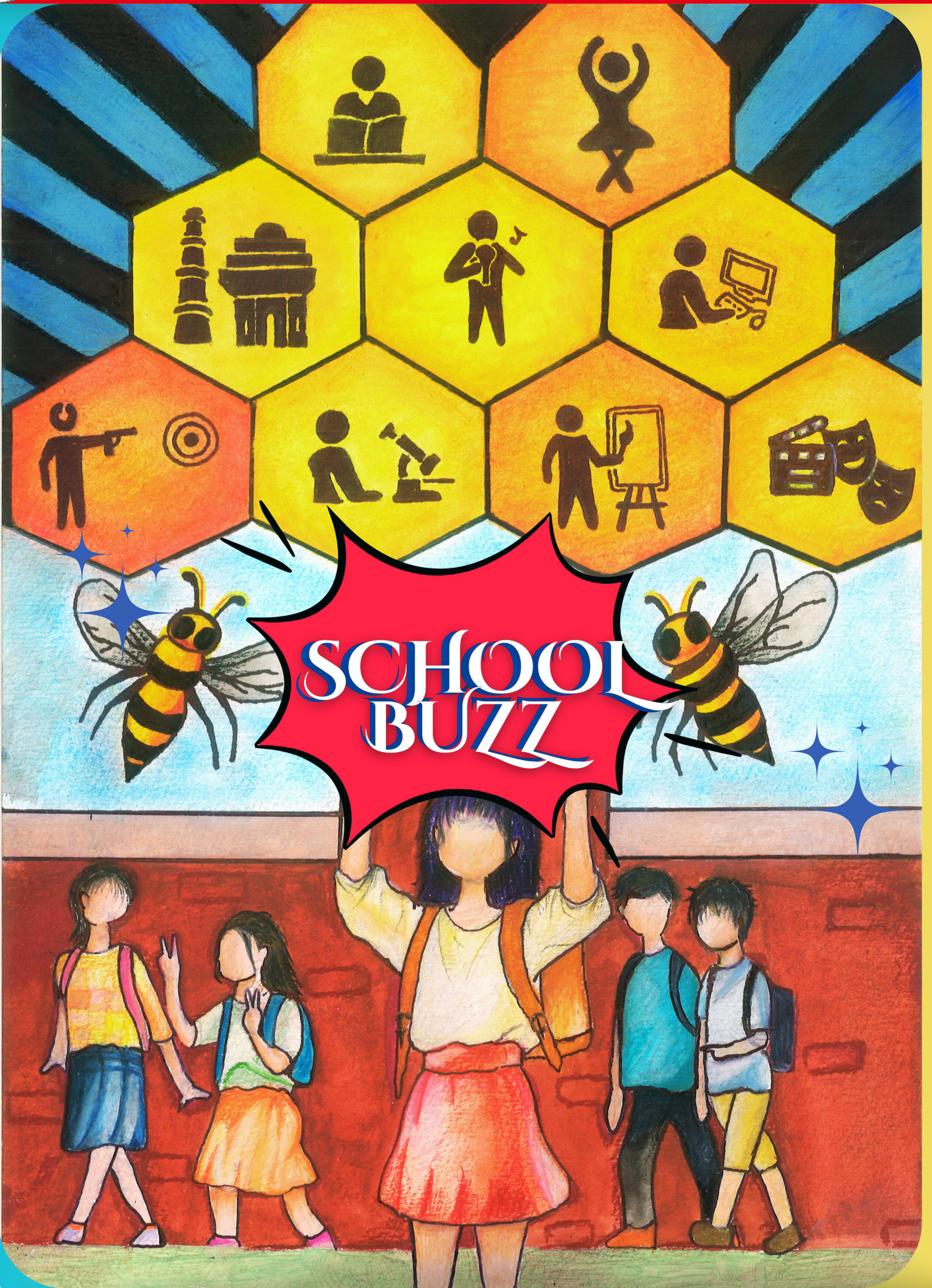

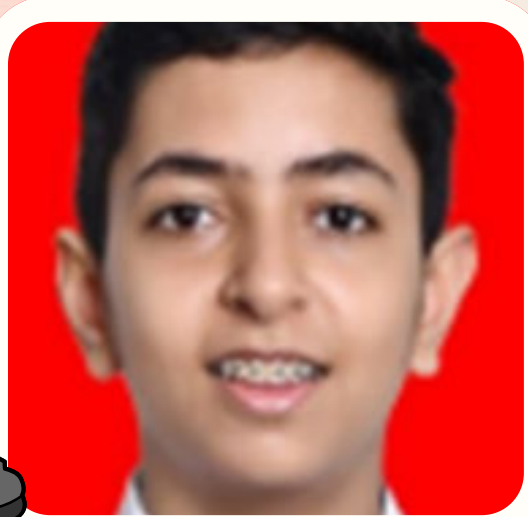


Our school won the Overall Sports Championship for the 12th consecutive year in Zone XI for 2023-2024.

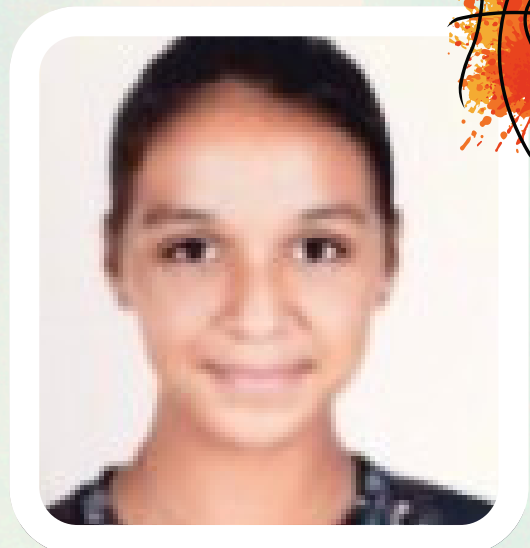

Scholarly Pursuits



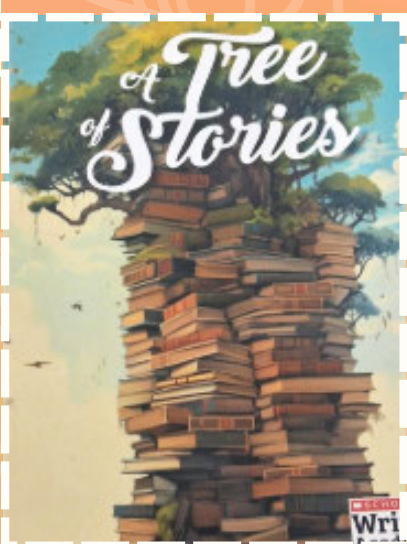
Nandini Jain of Class XI was awarded The Artivist Fellowship with a 50% scholarship by *Young Leaders for Active Citizenship*.

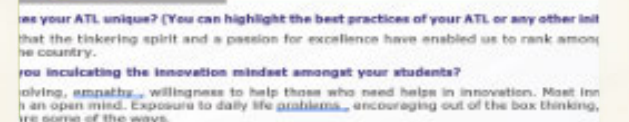

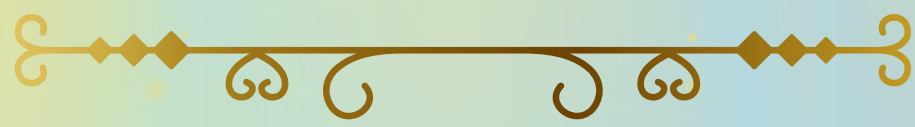
The event was a beautiful fusion of cultures, celebrating diversity through songs and dances, setting the perfect tone for the day!

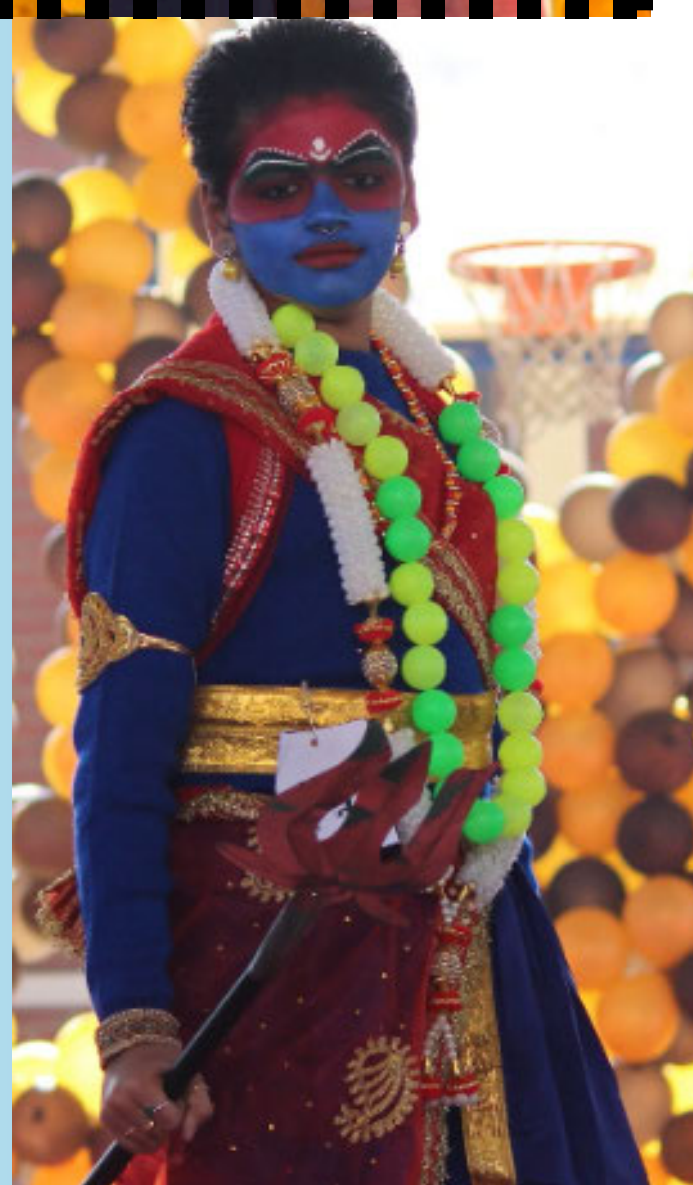

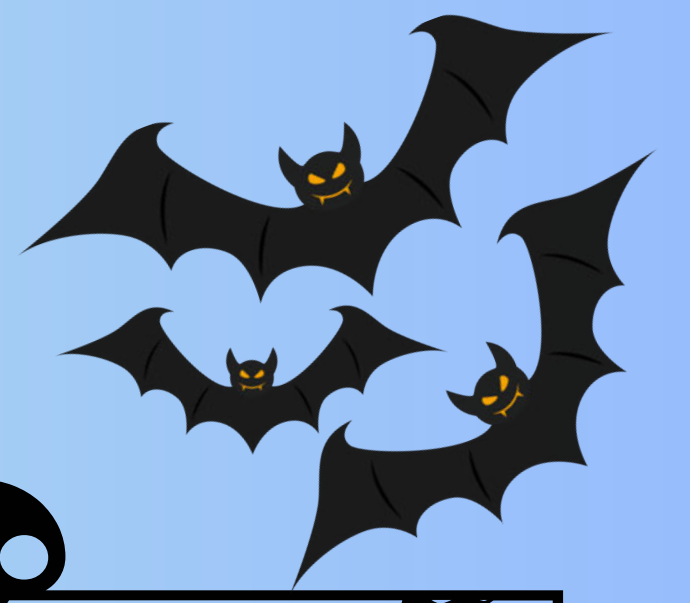

A Heartfelt Farewell to Our Beloved Class 12th

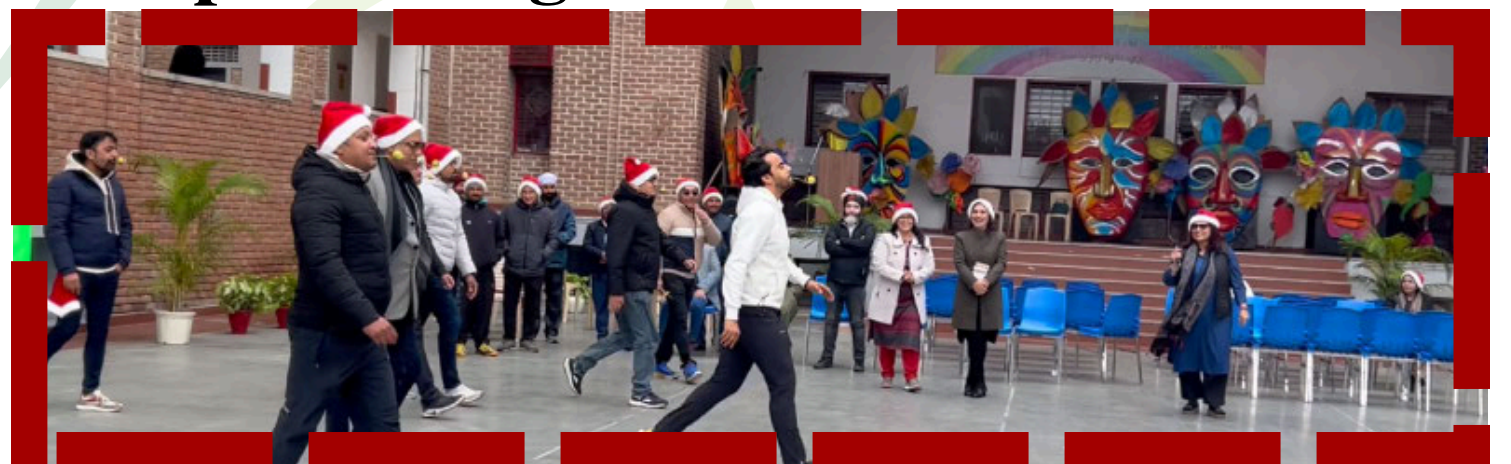
