Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the Upgradation of the existing secondary school to senior secondary level with effect from 1992-1993 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-


1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1973, as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit the students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of senior secondary classes by appointing more staff as per the norms of the department and subjectwise PGTs shall be appointed and Govt. nominee shall also be invited at the time of the selection of the Teachers.
4. That the school shall establish and equip all the three separate science Labs. as per the norms of the Department/CBSE. Separate Lab. Assistant for each Lab shall also be appointed.
5. That the proper Library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student and more approved standard books for senior classes and reference books for teachers shall be added.
6. That more sport material for out-door games shall be purchased and made available to the students.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act 1973, and payment shall be made through crossed cheque. Bonus, LTC., medical allowance, gratuity and pension as applicable to Govt. Employees of Delhi Admn. shall be paid to the employees of the school.
8. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class rooms of proper size in the school and each class room, science Labs. and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
9. That the school shall not run unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall run at one place at the above address only.

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10. That the school shall recruit the teachers and other employees as per recruitment rules framed under DSER 1973. Services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, shall be dispensed with immediate effect.
11. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 and 51 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
12. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.

SUB :- UPGRADEATION OF SCHOOL FROM MIDDLE TO SECONDARY STAGE WITH
EFFECT FROM ACADEMIC SESSION 1990-91 (WITHOUT AID)

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Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the upgradation of the existing Middle School to Secondary School level without aid w.e.f. 1990-91 to the fulfilment of the following terms & conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provision of DSER 73 framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste & creed.
3. That the school shall meet the additional liability of Secondary classes.
4. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading - room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
5. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
6. That the school shall strictly abide by the provision of section 10(i) of the DSER 1973.
7. That the school shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place.
8. That the school shall dispense with the service of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
9. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
10. Fresh Health Certificate from MD to be obtained and produced to E.O. for verification.
11. The Management Committee shall regulate the functioning of school strictly, in accordance with the provisions of DSER 1973.
12. Managing Committee of the school shall not increase fee in future academic session without prior approval of Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub section (3) of section 17 of DSER, 1973.

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13. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
14. Proof to the effect that qualified staff has been appointed as per R.Rs be provided for the verification of E.O.
15. That staff has been paid all arrears and being paid as per Fourth Pay Commission. Proof be given to E.O. for verification.
16. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers & sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month and presented to E.O. for verification.
17. That the school shall comply with the norms of the CBSE for affiliation for examination purposes.
18. Medical facilities/leave, ITC bonus, Teaching allowances, CPF etc. be paid since recognition of school.
19. Provident Fund Register be maintained and cash-book be completed and shown to E.O. of the zone concerned for verification from time to time.
20. ~~That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 10,000/-~~
21. That the violation of any instructions/conditions/rules & regulation of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
22. That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the E.O. every six month.

Sub:- Grant of recognition to the school from class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. academic session 1988-89 for a day school.

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Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject noted above, I am directed to grant recognition to your school from class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1988-89 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as well as the students issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination staff as per the norms of the department.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff as per the norms of the department.
4. That the school shall equip the science lab. as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. More materials worth Rs. 5000/- shall be purchased in during 1988-89 and a list be furnished to E.O. for verification.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student day be added and facilities of reading room may also be provided immediately and more books worth Rs. 5000/- be purchased by the start of next session and the list of books are furnished to E.O. for verification.
6. That adequate sports materials shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of DSE/R, 1973 and payment shall be made as per Sec.10(1) of DSE, 1973 to all employees.
8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Dte. of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of class-room of proper size in the school.
9. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified & overage staff, if any, immediately.
10. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.

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11. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provision of Rules 6, 7 & 9 be strictly observed.
12. That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the students/teacher and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local P.W.D. within a month.
13. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 5000/- only in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.
14. Proof to the effect that the staff has been appointed as per RR's be provided to the E.O. for his verification.
15. Copies of the appointment letters issued to the staff be provided to the E.O. for his verification.
16. Health Certificate be obtained from MCD and be submitted to E.O. within a month.
17. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school and class IX shall not opened without the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi.
18. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer Every six month.
